Parent/Legal Guardian Code of Conduct

Beverly Youth Football and Cheer(BYFC) requires that all Parents/ Legal Guardians adhere to the following rules of conduct:

- I will encourage and promote good sportsmanship and provide positive support to all players, coaches and officials at every game, practice or league event.
- I will leave the coaching to the coaching staff and encourage my child to participate in a manner consistent with the team's strategy or plan. If I have any concerns to address I will address outside of play or practice time and never while a team is on the playing field.
- I will provide support for coaches and officials working with the athletes to provide a positive experience for all. I will not undermine the coaches or officials authority.
- I will treat all players, coaches, officials, parents and spectators with dignity and respect in language, attitude, behavior and mannerisms. I understand that my behavior reflects on my child and on BYFC, and I will require the same of my child.
- I will not question the official's judgment or honesty in public. I recognize that officials are being developed in the same manner as players.
- I will refrain from the use of abusive or vulgar language, racial, ethnic or gender-related slurs at any time at the field or any BYFC function.
- I will be a positive role model and insist on a drug, alcohol and tobacco free environment at all practice and game fields.

I understand that I am agreeing to support and promote this Parent / Legal Guardian Code of Conduct Agreement. Further, my failure to comply with this agreement or my participation in conduct that violates this agreement will result in disciplinary action, up to and including expulsion from the BYFC Program.
