

2025 DAA BASKETBALL CHEERLEADING FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Dacula Athletic Association (DAA) Basketball Cheerleading is a recreational cheerleading league run by the DAA Cheerleading board in affiliation with Gwinnett Parks and Recreation. All children from ages 5 to 18 are eligible to cheer.

How do I register my child? Online registration begins October 1st at 9 am. Registration will remain open until October 27th or until all slots are filled.

What are the age requirements? Ages 5-18. Your child must be registered at least for Kindergarten in the Fall of 2025 (Occasionally we have taken a few 4 year old siblings) to be eligible to cheer.

What is the registration cost for my child? The Registration Fee is \$295. Registration Fee Includes: Uniform \$125, Spirit Fee \$50, and Admin/Facility Fees \$120. Spirit Fee goes towards the team for

individual expenses and banquet expenses. NOTE: The registration fee is not refundable. IMPORTANT – Gwinnett County charges an additional fee of \$90 for out of county registrants.

What is the uniform cost? Details for uniform will be emailed to parents once they have registered their cheerleader. The cost of an entire new uniform is \$125. (This includes top, bottom, bow and poms.)

If my child changes their mind after Registration, am I able to receive a refund? No, DAA does not issue refunds. Please make sure your family can commit to the cheer season before registering your child.

Do you offer payment plans? We do offer 2 payment options. You may pay in full OR you may spread the \$295 across two (2) payments. A credit card is required to be on file. The first payment is due upon registration, and the other payment is due NLT October 20th, 2025. There is an additional \$3 fee charged for this convenience. If any payment is returned, there will be an additional \$10 returned payment fee due. All payments are to be completed by October 20th by 10pm. Non-payment will result in the registration process being incomplete and your child will be unable to participate for the 2025 season.

Will there be any scholarships available? The Dacula Cheer Board will not accept applications for Basketball Cheer scholarships for the 2025 season. Gwinnett County Parks and Recreation may offer scholarships this season. Check their webpage or ours under (Scholarships) for more information.

Can my child cheer for their sibling's basketball team? Maybe. All teams will be a mix of ages and will rotate between basketball teams.

My child has never cheered before, is that ok? Yes! We welcome new cheerleaders (with experience or none) to our program at any grade.

Does my child need to know how to tumble? No, tumbling is not a requirement to cheer. We do encourage tumbling classes at the gym of your choice which will help them with flexibility, stability, strength and prepare them for Middle and High School.

How long is the season? The season begins November 2nd. The regular season runs through January. If the team that your child cheers for makes it to the playoffs, it can possibly run up until mid-February.

Where do the games take place? The games are spread out between the Dacula cluster schools. Every attempt is made to evenly distribute the home/away games. The game schedule and directions to each school will be provided to your team coach once available.

How much do they practice? Before the basketball season begins, all teams will participate in a mandatory 1-day camp. November 2nd 2025 Location TBD. Afterwards, teams will practice once a week on Tuesdays, with games scheduled on Saturdays and some Fridays. Regular practices will never be held on Sundays.

Does my child have to try out for a team? Every child is guaranteed a spot on a team.
