AT KYC OUR GOAL IS TO INSTILL DISCIPLINE AND SENSE OF RESPONSIBILITY IN ALL PARTICIPANTS. WE EXPECT PARENTS AND PARTICIPANTS TO FOLLOW GUIDELINES OUTLINED BELOW

GUIDELINES FOR KYC PARENTS

1. RESPECT THE COACHES AND ORGANIZERS DECISIONS REGARDING PRACTICES AND TEAM SELECTION
2. INDICATE YOUR AVAILABILITY VIA THE REQUESTED ELECTRONIC FORUM FOR EVERY PRACTICE/GAME. IF ADEQUATE PLAYERS ARE NOT AVAILABLE PRACTICES CAN BE RE-SCHEDULED OR CANCELLED. YOUR RESPONSES WILL ENABLE TIMELY COMMUNICATION TO ALL IN AN EVENT OF A CANCELLATION.
3. BE PUNCTUAL FOR PRACTICES AND GAMES
4. DURING PRACTICES/GAMES PLEASE STAY ON THE SIDELINES
5. BRING ADEQUATE AMOUNT OF DRINKS FOR YOUR CHILD TO AVOID DE-HYDRATION
6. DO NOT LITTER THE GROUNDS – CLEANUP AFTER EACH PRACTICE/GAME
7. OBEY THE SPEED LIMIT SIGNS IN THE NEIGHBORHOOD WHERE THE GROUND IS LOCATED
8. PAY YOUR DUES ON TIME – AFTER TWO REMINDERS YOUR CHILD WILL BE DENIED PARTICIPATION
9. DO NOT DROP OFF YOUR CHILD FOR PRACTICES/GAMES UNLESS ANOTHER PARENT IS WILLING TO TAKE RESPONSIBILITY. KYC COACHES AND ORGANIZERS WILL NOT TAKE RESPONSIBILITY FOR YOUR CHILD DURING PRACTICES/GAMES
10. EXPRESS YOUR SUGGESTIONS/GRIEVANCES TO MEMBERS OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE.

GUIDELINES FOR KYC PARTICIPANTS

1. RESPECT THE COACHES AND ORGANIZERS
2. UMPIRES DECISION WILL BE FINAL
3. TANTRUMS, GESTURES AND INAPPROPRIATE ACTIONS ON THE FIELD WILL NOT BE TOLERATED AND WILL RESULT IN DISCIPLINARY ACTION INCLUDING SUSPENSION/ EXPULSION FROM KYC
4. BE COURTEOUS TO YOUR TEAM MATES AND OPPONENTS – SPORTSMANSHIP IS A MUST
5. FOLLOW THE SAFETY RULES. VIOLATIONS OF SAFETY RULES WILL RESULT IN STRICT DISCIPLINARY ACTION INCLUDING SUSPENSION/EXPULSION FROM KYC
 - a. SWINGING OF BAT WILL NOT BE ALLOWED UNLESS YOU ARE ON THE PITCH AND BATTING (STRIKER)
 - b. BATSMAN HAS THE RIGHT OF WAY ON THE PITCH. FIELDERS, BOWLER AND NON-STRIKER WILL RESPECT THE RIGHT OF WAY
 - c. BATSMAN WHO IS FACING THE BALL (STRIKER) WILL ALWAYS RUN ON THE PITCH, NON-STRIKER WILL RUN OFF-THE-PITCH (GRASS)
 - d. BOWLER WILL NOT BOWL UNLESS THE BATSMAN IS READY TO TAKE THE STRIKE
 - e. DO NOT THROW THE BALL UNLESS THE RECEIVING PLAYER IS EXPECTING THE BALL AND IS READY
 - f. CALL OUT YOUR CATCHES BY SHOUTING “MINE”
6. DRESS APPROPRIATELY (SHORT/TROUSER AND SHIRT ARE REQUIRED)
7. PROPER FOOTWEAR (CLOSED TOE SHOES AND SOCKS) IS A MUST
8. BOYS SHALL WEAR PROTECTIVE CUP WHEN BATTING
