2026 League Construct

The information below is to define what can be expected in each division for the Spring 2026 season.

T-Ball: 4-5 year olds

What to expect: This division is designed for first time players or those that need another year developing the skills required to hit a live coach pitch. There are no player evaluations for this division. In order for 5 year olds to play up into the coach pitch division, you must have played one year of T-Ball.

Coach Pitch Baseball: 6-7 years olds

What to expect: This division is designed for those players that have played T-Ball and/or demonstrated the skills required to hit a live coach pitch. There are no player evaluations for this division. At age 5, If the league feels as though your player needs more time to develop their skills, we will make a recommendation to play in the T-Ball division. At age 7, if you feel as though they should play up in the Rookie division, they must attend the player evaluation. Your player must be drafted into the Rookie division in order to play up. If not, they will play in the Coach Pitch division.

Rookie Baseball Sr: 8 year olds

What to expect: This division is designed for those players that are ready to hit a live pitcher (kid and coach). There are player evaluations for this division. At age 8, if you feel as though they should play up in the Minor Division (kid pitch), they must attend the Minor League player evaluation. That player must be drafted into the division in order to play up. If not, they will play in the Rookie division.

Minor Division Baseball: 9-10 year olds

What to expect: This division is designed for those players that are ready to hit a live pitch from another player. There are player evaluations for this division. At age 10, if you feel as though they should play up in the Major Division, they must attend the Major League player evaluation. That player must be drafted into the division in order to play up. If not, they will play in the Minor division. Interleague could be a part of this division, which means games at MLL as well as at other leagues in our district.

Major Division Baseball: 11-12 year olds

What to expect: There are player evaluations for this division. Interleague could be a part of this division, which means games at MLL as well as at other leagues in our district.

50-70 Intermediate Baseball: 11-13 year olds

What to expect: This division is designed for the more advanced/competitive player. There will be tryouts for this division. The Intermediate (50/70) Baseball Division utilizes a 50-foot pitching distance and 70-foot base paths. The division, which was a new division of Little League Baseball in 2013 for players league age 11-13 with post season tournament opportunities, including a World Series, offers a transition for players between the standard Little League sized field (46/60) and the Junior/Senior sized field (60'6"/90). Regular season players in Little League Intermediate 50/70 Baseball Division have the opportunity to dual roster, this means that he/she can play in the Little League Major Baseball Division during the same season. Achieving tournament eligibility is possible in either division, as long as the player has met eligibility requirements. Interleague will be a part of this division, which means games at MLL as well as at other leagues in our district.

Senior Division Baseball 14-16 year old boys

What to expect: There are player evaluations for this division. Interleague will be a part of this division, which means games at MLL as well as at other leagues in our district.

Coach Pitch Softball: 5-6 years old girls

What to expect: This division is designed to introduce softball to young players. A coach will pitch to the players, but a tee will also be used to ensure player development. There are no player evaluations for this division. At age 6, if you feel as though they should play up in the Adv Coach Pitch Division, they must attend the player evaluation. Your player must be drafted into the Adv. Coach Pitch division in order to play up. If not they will play in the Coach Pitch division. Interleague could be a part of this division, which means games at MLL as well as at other leagues in our district.

Advanced Coach Pitch Softball: 7-8 year old girls

What to expect: This division is designed for those players that are ready to hit a live pitch from a coach. There are player evaluations for this division. At age 8, if you feel as though they should play up in the Minor Division (kid pitch), they must attend the Minor League player evaluation. That player must be drafted into the division in order to play up. If not, they will play in the Adv. Coach Pitch division. Interleague could be a part of this division, which means games at MLL as well as at other leagues in our district.

Minor Division Softball: 9-10 year old girls

What to expect: This division is designed for those players that are ready to hit a live pitch from another player. There are player evaluations for this division. At age 8, if the league feels as though your player needs more time to develop their skills, we will make a recommendation to play in the Adv. CP Division. At age 10, if you feel as though they should play up in the Major Division, they must attend the Major League player evaluation. That player must be drafted into the division in order to play up. If not they will play in the Minor division. Interleague will likely be a part of this division, which means games at MLL as well as at other leagues in our district.

Major Division Softball: 11-12 year old girls

What to expect: There are player evaluations for this division. At age 12, if you feel as though they should play up in the Junior/Senior Division, they must attend the Jr/Sr League player evaluation. That player must be drafted into the league in order to play up. If not they will play in the Major division. Interleague will be a part of this division, which means games at MLL as well as at other leagues in our district.

Junior Division Softball: 12-14 year old girls

What to expect: There are player evaluations for this division. At age 12, if the league feels as though your player needs more time to develop their skills, we will make a recommendation to play in the Major Division. At age 14, if you feel as though they should play up in the Senior Division, they must attend the Senior League Player Evaluation. That player must be drafted into the league in order to play up. If not they will play in the Junior division. Interleague will be a part of this division, which means games at MLL as well as at other leagues in our district. It is possible the Junior division is consolidated into the Senior division in order to find local competition.

Senior Division Softball 15-16 year old girls

What to expect: There are player evaluations for this division. Interleague will be a part of this division, which means games at MLL as well as at other leagues in our district.
