



Cascade Little League Code of Conduct



The mission of Cascade Little League is to assist our community by promoting and developing the qualities of Character, Courage and Loyalty through teamwork, socialization and sportsmanship.

To support our mission, we at Cascade Little League have implemented the following Code of Conduct for all coaches, players, umpires and spectators who participate or attend any Cascade Little League event. Any person guilty of improper conduct should be reported to a Cascade Little League board member or via email to info@cascadelittleleague.org.

1. I will encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, umpires and spectators.
2. I will not engage in kind of unsportsmanlike conduct such as booing, taunting, bullying, use of profane/abusive language/gestures or inappropriate physical contact.
3. I will never ridicule any participant for making a mistake or losing a competition.
4. I will respect umpires and their authority during a game and will not question judgement calls.
5. I will refrain from coaching during games and practices unless I am one of the coaches on the team.
6. I will not use social media to be critical of coaches, players, umpires, volunteers or other spectators.
7. I will not come to a Cascade Little League event with or under the influence of drugs, alcohol or marijuana.
8. I will not use any tobacco or vaping product at a Cascade Little League event.
9. I will not have gum or seeds on the turf fields.
10. I will respect the complex and equipment provided.
11. I will abide by [Little League Best Practices Covid-19](#) guidance as well as state Washington [Safe Start reopening Plan](#).

Cascade Little League has adopted a policy of ZERO TOLERANCE. Violators of the code of conduct will be removed from a Little League activity in a situation where the above code is not followed. If the violator refuses to leave, the team associated with that individual will forfeit the game and the incident may be reported to local police department for review. Coaches are held responsible for actions of their players and spectators and may also be impacted by violators of this policy.
