

# RRSGSL Background Check Policy

All volunteers assisting teams in practice and/or games must complete a volunteer application, pass a background check and be approved by the board of directors.

Automatic disqualification will be rendered for any conviction of the following offenses: any offense against a minor, crime of child abuse, child neglect, sexual assault, indecent exposure, public lewdness, kidnapping, murder, and voluntary manslaughter.

Automatic disqualification will be rendered for any conviction of the following offenses within the last ten (10) years: aggravated assault, arson, robbery, burglary, or terrorist threat.

Automatic disqualification will be rendered for any conviction of the following offenses within the last five (5) years: Felony violation of the Controlled Substance Act.

Automatic disqualification will be rendered for any combination of two or more convictions during the past seven years or one offense within the last two (2) years for the following offenses: Assault, Driving while Intoxicated (DWI), Driving Under Influence (DUI), Possession of Marijuana, any level violation of the Controlled Substance Act, or Theft.

This list of offenses is not intended to be all-inclusive and in no way sets limits on the offenses that are deemed grounds for disqualifying an individual from affiliation with RRSGL. The board of directors reserves final authority.

Background checks are valid for a period of 12 months.
