The rules stated are modifications to the USA & NFHS rule books. If a rule is not modified, it is governed by USA & NFHS.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Finish the inning when time expires. • All players in attendance must be listed in the batting order, and given the opportunity to bat. • Free substitutions for players in the field, a player may return to any position any number of times, with the exception of the pitcher. She may only return once to the pitching position. • If a player cannot continue for any reason after the game has started, her position in the lineup may be skipped without taking an out; however she cannot return to the game. • A player who arrives after the line-up has been established will be added to the bottom of the line-up. • Courtesy Runner may only be used for the catcher and only if there are 2 outs. Courtesy Runner is player with Last Out. • Any pitcher who hits (3) three consecutive batters must be removed from the circle for the remainder of that inning. Any pitcher who hits (5) batters total, will be removed from the circle for the remainder of the game. • No Intentional Walks allowed 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 5 warm up pitches first inning / entry, 3 remaining innings. • Run ahead rule – 12 after 3, 10 after 4 or 8 after 5 innings. • (2) Two full innings is considered a complete game in the event the game cannot be completed. • If (2) two complete innings have not been completed, and the game is postponed. The game will be restarted at the exact point where it was stopped prior to being postponed. • No Ties, Both Fall and Spring games will go to Modified ITB. Last Plate Appearance on Base. • Fall is limited to 3 ITB innings and may result in a tie. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Bases Loaded; 2 Outs • Spring – Progressive ITB, Must have Winner <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Runner on Second; 2 Outs 2. Runner on Second and Third; 2 Outs 3. Bases Loaded; 2 Outs • TBall is limited to 1 ITB Inning; Spring and Fall • Less than 7 rostered players playing is a forfeit. The game will still be played, but will count as a forfeit.
