#### 8. New Business

#### **Concerns:**

1. Recruitment of referees and coaches is a GREAT concern for the club, especially for the spring when the U14 and U18 teams play. We were able to host a referee course and certify 7 young referees. Please send interested individuals to Jed and/or the web-site for more information. HSC will host another in-person event if there is enough interest. Players aged 13 may referee.

Individuals interested in getting certified are to contact Jed Grice for more information. HSC reimburses for registration/certification/clearance cost.

2. For information only ~ High School Soccer Boosters are in need of executive board members

The high school boys have established a non-profit called McGuffey Boys Soccer Moms with and EIN.

Coach Scoop and Vince need to work with the McGuffey Soccer Boosters and the McGuffey Boys Soccer Moms to determine a path forward that benefits male and female middle and high school teams. Coach Scoop that he would work with all parties to make this happen. The biggest concern was how to keep that concession stand operational during games at the stadium, whether we offer other teams like the cheerleaders to take a %; mandate that middle school soccer parents volunteer. To Jed Grice's knowledge, the Vice President's position for the McGuffey Soccer Boosters remains vacant and he was unsure to the intent of Dean Yendell to stay on as Booster President.

- 3. The executive board met with Brinton Ealy in regards to having additional poles set and lights placed on the U18 field. Pole set is currently charging \$1,800 per pole. The executive board tabled the purchasing of poles until the price comes down. Brinton Ealy is going to create a light structure for the U6 fields 2 & 3, and replace the older bulbs with cheaper LEDs.
- 4. Need volunteers to learn how to use the AED machine and help schedule a couple evenings/times to train coaches on how to use the device.

Members in attendance spoke to the fact that we have a number of parents at the fields with a medical background, and possibly we could have them volunteer to show parents and coaches on practice nights how to use the AED device.

- 2. HSC will need to explore having the kickboards on field 5 and 6 treated/painted. The club will look to have this done by the McGuffey Art Club, an Eagle Scout Project, or maybe a Senior Project.

Coach Scoop offered to have the boys soccer team paint the kickboards as a service project. Brandon Harris mentioned that his daughter was a member of the Art Club, and could possibly arrange for something HSC or McG Soccer to be painted.
