#### 2. General:

  - i. All softball divisions
    - 1. Any potential need for players to move up divisions will be coordinated with the team managers. Come to your registered division time.
  - ii. Players new to minors baseball
    - 1. All Farm of league age 8 will be invited to account for any roster openings in the minors.
      - a. Only those that accept the invitation will be considered to be drafted in the minors.
  - iii. Players new to majors baseball
    - 1. All minors of league age 10 will be invited to account for any roster openings in the majors.
      - a. Only those that accept the invitation will be considered to be drafted in the majors.
  - iv. Division schedule for try-outs on the 23rd and email invites to be sent by the end of the week.
