2. General:

- a. Date for an equipment swap/donation to be communicated this week.

- c. Picture Days:
 - i. Friday April 4th, drafted divisions. (Starting at 6:00PM)

- d. Coaching Selections:
 - i. Selection of team personnel are solely made based on volunteer roles made in SportsConnect. Volunteer for the role that you are to be considered to perform.
 - ii. There is a vetting process per our by-laws for coach selections, however the league generally does not have enough volunteer coaches each season, especially with the head coach/manager roles, where we would have to make a decision between volunteers. If there have been no formal reported complaints and a clean background check, all volunteer coaches are assigned to their requested role.
 - iii. The league makes every effort to have at least 3 coaches per team, especially with our younger divisions.
- e. Code of Conduct: Code of conduct is a 3-way-street between player, parent, and coach.
 - i. Coaches sign Coach's Contract.
 - ii. Parents agree to both parent and player code of conduct upon registration.
 - iii. The league has an established disciplinary process for conduct violations per the by-laws.
 - 1. The league doesn't have an HR Dept or Social Workers, just volunteers.
 - Things can get competitive or emotional. Adults are expected to act like adults. The league expects parents and coaches shall communicate properly and work to diffuse any situation prior to requiring escalation. Please let the coaches coach.
 - 3. Should any issue of misconduct be observed, from parent, player or coach, it must be formally reported to the league in writing.
 - You may discuss with any board member verbally, however any claim must be documented accordingly. Board members have been instructed to advise on the formal reporting of misconduct claims.

- c. All rosters are at capacity with the amount of volunteer roles available.
 - i. Have enough players for another tee-ball and farm team, but not enough coaches to support additional teams.
