

Apex Soccer Academy Parents Code of Conduct

PURPOSE

The purpose of the Apex Soccer Academy (ASA) Parents Code of Conduct Policy is to outline the necessary steps to foster a positive environment for developing our athletes. Essential to the developmental experience is a focus on the highest level of good sportsmanship on the part of ASA staff, players, families, volunteers, and referees. Apex Soccer Academy believes that the basis of good sportsmanship is based on treating each other with respect, playing the game of soccer in a fair manner. Every person must realize that their actions have far reaching impacts on others. ASA parents are expected to practice good sportsmanship as defined:

1. Caring about the athlete over winning - winning is a byproduct of the investment of time into developing each athlete.
2. Accept the results of the game by being humble in victory and gracious in defeat.
3. Development of the entire athlete, not just soccer but also life skills.
4. Be positive and encouraging at all times.
5. Lead by example by conducting yourself in the highest moral and ethical behavior.
6. Be respectful and courteous of referees, ASA staff, volunteers, athletes and coaches.
7. Verbal or physical abuse is not allowed.
8. Do not lose control of your temper.
9. Do not use profanity.
10. Do not criticize, harass, heckle or disrespect athletes, coaches, referees, ASA staff, volunteers or the opposing team.
11. Demand excellence from athletes on and off the field of soccer.
12. Arrive on time for practice and games.
13. No coaching from the sidelines, only positive encouragement.
