GENERAL Rules of Conduct

- 1) When coming to the game, set up on the opposite side of the coach / team and STAY THERE. Only the coach and their Asst. coach are allowed on the team side, unless the coach asks you to come over to attend to a child. Do not wander behind the goals or to the other side and "Parent Coach."
- 2) ONLY POSITIVE cheering for both teams! We will not tolerate any infraction here.
- 3) Understand the Coaches and all personnel are VOLUNTEERS. They are sacrificing their time and energy for the betterment of your child and the community. All of us can't thank them enough for this!
- 4) Lets make it so all of us have FUN!
- 5) Pick up after yourself. Please pick up trash, water bottles and such.
- 6) SAY rules dictate no pets are allowed on sidelines.
- 7) There will be no yelling at the referees. We will not tolerate any infraction here.
- 8) Understand that Board members also have the right, if they see infractions, to red card you, the parent.
- 9) Failure to follow the MAIN RULES OF CONDUCT listed within can cause your entire family to forfeit current and FUTURE registration within GSSA.
