Referee Registration Instructions

New Registrations on the GSSA website

f you have previously registered one or more of your children to play and/or referee soccer, you can skip ahead to the ref registration.

If you are new to GSSA—again, meaning that you have never registered yourself or any family members for *any* GSSA-related activities (playing, coaching refereeing) on the website, follow these steps:

1. Go to www.gssasoccer.com and click the REGISTER button in the upper right




corner of the screen.

2. Enter the email address which you wish to register on the GSSA Sports Connect (or Stack Sports) website and click "Continue"


3. Create a Password and again click "Continue"




4. Go to your inbox for the email address which you registered and click the link on the email from Stack Sports to "Verify Email"



5. On the "What would you like to do today?", you would typically select "Register My Players". Note that for registration purposes the new referee candidate or returning referee who is registering for a new season is treated as a <u>player</u>. There is no separate category or role for a referee when it comes to registration.




6. The next page says "Okay, let's get to know you first." Here you will enter information about yourself and your contact details. You also have the option to link your registration to another person such as a spouse or guardian for the child. Once you have completed all required fields click "Continue" and



you will come to a screen which asks you how many kids you want to register in this session; you can always return and register yourself and additional children later. Again, click "Continue" and you will proceed to completing information about the kids you wish to register.

7. Enter the information for the child you wish to register. In the screen print below, I have created a fictional person named Craig Johnson whose date-of-birth is March 12, 2010, making Craig eligible to take the class in February 2022 and begin to ref for the spring season. Also, keep in mind that if your child will turn 12 by September, they can take this class in February and wait to begin reffing until the fall season since the class is not offered in the summer.

On the Player Information screen you can check the box for "Yes" if your child has the same address as you registered for yourself. Un-check the box if you need to enter a different address—such as that of the other parent. When all




fields are complete, click "Continue" in the lower right corner of the screen.

This completes the registration on the GSSA website and the process of creating a player/referee record for a child. Next, let's move on to the steps for registering as a referee for the upcoming season and/or referee training class.

Registering as a New or Returning Referee For the Upcoming Season

When you have registered as a new user of the GSSA Sports Stack website or successfully signed in to an existing account, you should see a message for each eligible child which may say something like "Lisa has 2 Available Programs." One of those programs could be the soccer age level for which your child is eligible. The other should be the referee program (if your child is 12 or older as of September 1 later this year).


1. In the Referee Registration - Spring 2022, click the View Divisions button over on the right side of the screen.




2. In the following screen, where it says "Referee registrant" and \$0, click the "Select" button and then click "Continue."




- 3. Complete the fields in "Please fill out the program questions below"
 - A. Click "View/Accept" in the Liability Waiver section
 - B. From the dropdown menu for "Preferred level to ref." If you are a new referee taking the February 2022 class, select "Instructional Only" or "Instructional and Passers" or "Passers only" In the first two seasons, new referees are only eligible to ref Instructional and/or Passers games.
 - C. Enter the full name for the parent or guardian who is electronically signing the liability waiver and registering the child as a referee.



4. In the next screens you could register other children or yourself if you are a referee too. If you have no further registrations to complete, click "Skip"



- 5. Order Summary: total due will say \$0.00. Click "Continue" and you'll proceed to the checkout for the shopping cart.
- 6. Select the radio dial for "I do not wish to donate at this time" and then "Submit Order" in the lower right corner to complete the registration.



After clicking Submit Order the process is complete. Your child will be added to the roster of registered referees. For prospective referees interested in taking the class in late February, we will use that roster information to create the class roster.

Please see the class announcement email for details on making payment, the class dates, what to bring to class and other information.
