

MORADA LOCAL LEAGUE RULES- 50/70 and Junior Division

1. 50/70 Division will consist of players little league age 13, 12 with board approval. The junior division will consist of players little league age 13-15.
2. Managers must have a minimum of 2 years coaching experience in the Minor A division or higher, unless approved by the Morada Little League Board of directors
3. All league age 14- and 15-year-olds will be drafted into the Junior Division.
4. Teams will bat a continuous line up. All rostered players in attendance will bat.
5. Players that have played in the Junior or 50/70 division at Morada in a prior spring season are considered property of their existing team and only need to attend player assessments / try outs in the event they are league age eligible to play in a different division and want to be considered available for the draft of the other division. Or if there is an expansion or reduction to teams greater than 2.
6. Immediately after the game, both managers will verify accuracy of the official scorebook for minimum play requirements, and pitch counts. Both managers and head umpires must sign the official scorebook or verify the accuracy in gamechanger and pitch count logs.
7. A 15-run rule will be in place after 4 innings. 3.5 if the home team is ahead.
8. A 10-run rule will be in place after 5 innings. 4.5 if the home team is ahead.
9. League age 15 year olds are eligible to pitch and catch.
10. Teams will follow the attached listed rules for District 8 play
11. End of season tournament: with 3 or more teams will be a double elimination tournament. The regular season overall record will determine ranking for the tournament. In the event of a tie, the tie breaker will be determined by first the In League Record; in the event there is still a tie, seeding will be based off head-to-head record. The winner of the tournament will represent Morada in the Tournament of Champions. With 2 teams the tournament will be a best of 3 game tournament.
