

## **All Star Player Selection Committee Member**

Committee members will be responsible for attending / viewing games and/or practices throughout the current season and in all divisions.

1. Committee members will be first nominated from the current Morada Board of Directors members. If 4 majority nominated members are not confirmed then nominations will be opened to current season team managers and voted on by the current Board of Directors.

## **All-Star Manager Selections**

1. Minor A, Major, Intermediate, and Junior level coaches and/or managers interested in managing an All-Star team must submit an application to the current league Vice President and President by the communicated date but no later than May 15th indicating their age level preference (8-10,10-12, ect.)

2. Prospective All-Star managers may apply for more than one All Star team.

3. All interested coaches/managers must be in good standing within the league, according to the following criteria:

a. All prospective All-Star managers must be from the official list of approved managers/coaches for the current season.

b. All required volunteer paperwork has been turned in and approved.

c. All prospective All-Star managers must exhibit the ideals of fair play in keeping with the spirit of Little League Baseball.

4. All Prospective All-Star managers must have participated in a minimum of 60% of their team's regular season games in some capacity (Manager/Asst. Coach).

5. The Board of Directors will review the All-Star Manager applications and vote on individual team Managers at a meeting of the Board of Directors no later than May 30th.

6. If only one application is received for an individual age group, that applicant shall be deemed the All-Star Manager for that particular team upon Board approval.

7. If more than one application is received for an individual All-Star team, the managing positions will be selected by a democratic voting process (ballot, silent, open, or other mutually agreed upon process).

8. Prospective managers who are also current board members may contribute a vote.

9. In the event of a tie between two (2) or more prospective All-Star managers, a re-vote must take place between the tied applicants.

10. In the event that the voting is still tied between two (2) or more applicants, the League President will blind draw 3 members to vote. Voting will be in a manner consistent with the original vote.

11. Selected All Star Managers must select two official coaches and submit their names in writing to the League President, Vice President and Player Agent by May 31st.

## **All star player selection**

1. Phase 1: Managers from all competitive divisions (Minor A, Majors, Intermediate, Juniors) select all players from their current season team they believe are deserving to represent Morada on the 8-10, 9-11, 10-12, 11-13 and 13-14 year old Morada all star teams.

a. Criteria managers should be evaluating at games and practices include but not limited too

i. Talent level: this includes how the player throws, catches, fielding grounders and fly balls, number of quality at bats over the course of the season.

ii. Coachability: all star season is short and not a lot of practice time. Do they pay attention at practice? Do they pick up things quickly?

iii. Attitude: all star coaches/all star teams are not able to deal with poor attitudes from the player or the parents? Attitudes can bring the all star team down and make them unsuccessful.

iv. Effort: Are they lazy? Do they work hard at practice and at the games? Can the all star team count on this player to give a 100% all the time?

v. Baseball IQ: Do they know what to do with the ball when they get it? Do they understand baseball situations without being told what to do with it? Do they understand the strike zone?

b. The manager will submit in writing the players name, his little league age, and the reasoning why the players name was submitted.

2. Phase 2: The manager of the all star team and the four members of Player Selection committee that was formed by the Morada little league board of directors will take the submissions from phase 1 and have a war room to go through all the players discussing and forming the best possible team for Morada Little league taking into account all the criteria from above. If the committee or All Star manager believes that a player was left off the nomination list during phase 1, they may reach out to the regular season manager to determine why said kid was not nominated. The committee and manager should have rationales for how and why the team was formed in such a manner. The manager of the all star team will have 2 player selections of their own while the other 10 players the committee and manager must agree on.
