

# MORADA LOCAL LEAGUE RULES – Major Division

1. Only baseball players league age 9-12 are eligible to participate in the major division.
2. Managers must have 2 years coaching experience in the minor division to be eligible, unless approved by the Morada little league board of directors.
3. Immediately after each game, both managers and the head umpire will verify the accuracy of the official scorebook for minimum playing requirements as well as pitch county accuracy.
4. The major division will consist of 1 division with all major's teams only.
5. Teams will bat a continuous line up. All rostered players in attendance will bat.
6. In accordance with the Little League Mandatory Play regulation for the regular season all rostered players must play a minimum of 6 defensive outs per game. If unable to complete the requirement during any given game the player will start the next scheduled game and play in addition to the additional defensive outs in addition to that game's mandatory play.
7. A new inning shall not be started after 2 hours.
8. All home runs must clear the fence. If the ball hits the yellow rail and comes back into play, the ball is live. If the ball hits anything beyond the yellow line and comes back into play it is a home run.
9. All 12-year-olds will be drafted into the major division or higher. Only the strictest exceptions will be allowed by District 8.
10. Players that have played in the Major division at Morada in a prior spring season are considered property of their existing team and only need to attend player assessments / tryouts if they are league age eligible for a higher division (50/70 or Juniors) and want to be considered available for the draft of a higher division or in the event of an expansion or reduction of team in the current division.
11. Replacement players: in the event a team loses a player, the manager must notify the player agent immediately. The player agent will contact the player and try to resolve the issue. If it is determined the player will no longer be a part of the team, the manager will have up to 10 days to select a replacement player from the Player Agents eligible players list within the given appropriate league age for the division. Only the player agent will notify all replacement players. The replacement player picked will have had to attend the player assessment / tryout process prior to the start of the current season.
12. End of season tournament: This will be a double elimination tournament. The regular season overall record will determine ranking for the tournament. In the event of a tie, the tie breaker will be determined by first the head-to-head record; in the event there is still a tie, seeding will be based on In League Record. The winner of the tournament will represent Morada in the Tournament of Champions.
13. End of season tournament: the home team in the winners bracket will be the higher seeded team. For the losers bracket the home team will be decided by a coin flip regardless of seeding.
