

GLL Division Age Brackets and Player Test / Move up Rules

The following age brackets and player movement policies for GLL (Gloversville Little League) are established in accordance with the official age determination charts of Little League International and under the regulations set forth by Little League International.

These brackets meet the requirements of the Little League International Charter and have been reviewed, agreed upon, and formally implemented by the GLL Board of Directors and are part of the approved Local Rules and ByLaws.

Baseball Divisions

Division Age Brackets

Player placement is based on official Little League “league age” as determined by the Little League International age chart.

- Tee Ball (T-Ball): League Ages 4–6
- Bantam: League Ages 7–8
- Minors: League Ages 9–10
- Majors: League Ages 11–12

Baseball – Eligibility to Test and Move Up

Players may be eligible to test for advancement to the next division only if overall registration numbers across all divisions justify such movement, as determined by the GLL Board. Parent must send a written request to GLL. Do NOT place request in Special COmment section of registration.

The following players are eligible to test for move-up consideration:

- T-Ball: League Age 6 players who have completed one (1) year of T-Ball
- Bantam: League Age 8 players
- Minors: League Age 10 players

Eligibility to test does not guarantee advancement.

Softball Divisions

Division Age Brackets

Player placement is based on official Little League “league age” as determined by the Little League International age chart.

- Coach Pitch: League Ages 6–8
- Minors: League Ages 9–10
- Majors: League Ages 11–12

Softball – Eligibility to Test and Move Up

Players may be eligible to test for advancement to the next division only if overall registration numbers across all divisions justify such movement, as determined by the GLL Board. Parent must send a written request to GLL.

The following players are eligible to test for move-up consideration:

- Coach Pitch: League Age 8 players
- Minors: League Age 10 players

Eligibility to test does not guarantee advancement.

Move-Up Evaluation Process

1. Separate Evaluation Required

Any player requesting to test up must participate in a separate evaluation to determine whether they meet the performance criteria established by GLL.

2. Qualification Determination

- If the player meets the established criteria, they will be permitted to participate in evaluations for the division to which they are seeking advancement.
- If the player does not meet the criteria, they will remain in their age-appropriate division as determined by their official Little League league age.

3. Evaluation Participation

Players who do not qualify for advancement will only participate in evaluations within their league-age division, if evaluations are required for that division.

These policies ensure compliance with Little League International regulations while maintaining fair and developmentally appropriate placement for all GLL players.
