

Executive Board Minutes

Coach and Fan Behavior

The rules will be as follows:

- If any fan or coach becomes unruly, offensive or considered to be disruptive to the game ONE warning will be given to ALL fans/coaches.
- If anyone after that warning acts or does anything that the umpire feels to be disruptive toward his job or the game the fan or coach will be ejected from the field. At that point an executive board member will escort the fan or coach off site to the parking lot (If an executive board member is not present then a board member should be sought out). It is understood that parents may need to stay in the parking lot until their child is done but it is expected that there will be no issues after this point.
- If a fan or coach is ejected and sent to the parking lot and is still unruly or disruptive the police will be called without warning.
- If the police are called there will be an automatic 3 game suspension for the fan or coach. At this point the fan or coach is allowed nowhere on the grounds (including the parking lot).
- The board will then meet to discuss if further action is needed.

As a reminder all parents signed the following code of conduct at registration:
