

Tryout Policy for All Players:

All coaches will be able to attend and possibly participate in all club tryouts for their age\gender and 1 year younger. Boys team coaches may attend girls try outs as well. Age groups will be strictly adhered to during the tryout selection process. Players can only play at their same age level or 1 year older, provided there is a team in that age bracket. However; Players MUST play for the same age level team if they are selected. If no team is available for them in their same age group, Players can request to try out for a team 1 year older. For example, all 2004 players will be first available for 2004 teams (1). If a player is selected to a team and declines the invitation they will not be able to continue with draft process (2).

The team in each age\gender group (if multiple exist) with the fewest players on the roster will be given first choice of player selection followed by the next lowest roster count and so on. A team with a "Full Roster" will be taken out of the player selection rotation until other team's roster reaches "Full Team" status as displayed below. At that time, a round robin selection will resume.

- 11v11 15 players
- 9v9 13 players
- 7v7 10 players
- 4v4 7 players
 - (1) The appropriate age\gender team will have first right of selection and then player(s) will become available to be selected by other teams in this order:
 - 1. Other teams of same age\gender with teams under the "Full Roster" status
 - 2. Other same age\gender teams with full team status
 - 3. Older\same gender teams with teams without full team status
 - 4. Older\same gender teams with full team status.
 - 5. Girls may be drafted on to same age or older Boys team if no other acceptable options are available.

(2) Players selected to a team that refuse the invitation may not continue with the draft selection and the team that selected the player will be given the next pick. The player may appeal to the coaching director and/or Club President. It will be at the sole discretion of the Coaching Director

and/or Club President if the player will be allowed to play for another team. Coaches /Team Managers and other members of teams caught persuading players to not join other teams will lose 2 rounds of draft picks and may be asked to resign position.

Any remaining players after all teams have reached the prescribed numbers above will be drafted in a round robin for teams of said age group (example 2004 teams) beginning with the team that has had the longest time since last draft not including the drafts to get to the "full team" status. If this information is not available then a team name drawing (a) shall determine the team with the next pick.

- *This process may be overruled if age division has been assigned by levels of play i.e. A & B squad or Black, Maroon & White team levels. These age groups will be assigned by the coaching director and/or president of club and will follow the proper age groups.
- *Coaches who find players shall refer them to the proper channel (club phone, email or website) to set up a tryout for club teams regardless of age or gender of player. Coaches shall not recruit players directly to team but must follow the correct method in what is best for the club as a whole.
- *Teams with players playing up (registered players) in age before 3/8/2017 will be grandfathered in and may keep those players. After 3/8/2017 they may only add players playing up if they follow the above tryout policy. Players playing up that leave these teams must use the tryout policy to join club again.
- (a) Team name drawing: ticket with team name x3 will be placed in bucket or hat. the first team name drawn will have first pick and then second team drawn will have second pick and so forth until all teams names have been drawn then this order will proceed until all players are selected. If players remain after this then please view rule 1.
