

Summer 2026 Archery Camp is open to students entering 4th grade through 12th grade in the fall.

- * **Week 1- June 22nd-25th:** Ideal for beginners or campers who have never participated in a NASP program/camp before.
 - * Returning archers may register for Week 1 if they cannot attend Week 2, but please note that instruction may move a bit slower at the start.
- * **Week 2 – June 29th-July 2nd:** Designed for returning archers or campers with prior NASP experience.
 - * Campers who are brand new may attend Week 2 if they cannot make Week 1.
 - * Students who have taken archery in PE are also welcome.

Camp Details

- * Time: 8:00 AM – 11:00 AM
- * Location: Windsor Knolls Middle School Gym
- * Cost: \$150 per camper
- * Capacity: Limited to 30 archers per week (hard cap—cannot exceed)

Bows, arrows, and targets will be provided. Campers will need to purchase a glove for the camp, we do a lot of shooting, and this will help protect their fingers from getting sore. Gloves can be purchased for about \$10 online.

About NASP: The National Archery in the Schools Program (NASP) is a nationwide physical education initiative that teaches students the lifelong sport of archery through safe, consistent, and developmentally appropriate methods. Our camp follows all official NASP guidelines.

- * Proper form, aiming, and scoring
- * Concentration, confidence, and goal-setting

What Campers Should Bring:

- * Water bottle and a snack
- * Comfortable clothing
- * Closed-toe shoes (No flip-flops or Crocs)
- * Optional: Personal bow (must be a Genesis Original)
