- *Masks to be worn by coaches indoors and outdoors.
- * Masks to be worn by parents and spectators indoors and outdoors.
- *Players should wear masks to and from the fields/court. Masks are optional when engaging in a practice or game.
 - *Families will provide sanitizer for their child.
 - *All practices and games are optional.
- *Players recommended to use their own personal equipment.
- *No High fives or hand shakes.

*Restrooms will be open.

Concession stands will be open at most facilities.

- *Advanced sanitation procedures have been implemented at all facilities.
 - * Spectators recommended to social distance when attending games.
 - *Games and tournaments will be conducted in accordance with the state guidelines in the designated area of capacity.
- * Individuals 65 and over or with known high-risk medical conditions are highly recommended to remain cautious and adhere to social distancing guidelines.
- *If a player or coach is experiencing cough, fever, sore throat or any COVID-19 related symptoms DO NOT attend practice and consult your physician. A physician's note will be required for returning.*

Daily Self Evaluation

1. In the last 72 hours have you had a fever or chills and/or taken medication for a fever? (If you are unsure, please utilize a thermometer for an accurate reading. A temperature of 100.4 or higher constitutes a fever according to medical professionals)
2. Do you have symptoms concerning for COVID-19 such as new or worsening cough, shortness of breath or sore throat?
3. In the past 14 days have you been in close contact (was within 6 feet for longer than 10 min without protective equipment) with a person known/suspected to have COVID-19 and/or have you been diagnosed with COVID-19?
4. 4. Have you or anyone in your household been tested for COVID-19 and are still awaiting test results?

PROCEDURE IN CASE OF POSITIVE COVID-19 TEST

1. The individual should let the CDC Office know immediately by calling 317-846-1663 ext 3314.
2. The Hamilton County Health Department will be contacted by Carmel Dads' Club for additional guidance.
