Directions for team access and messaging can Access be found on our coach program page. Click here to learn more Team Note that you must be first be registered as a coach to access a team. Print your coach ID card, official roster (all ages) and your player Print ID cards (U13+). Recruit an assistant coach from team parents and direct them to Find register. Anyone assisting you with practices or games is required to register and complete the background check and SafeSport **Assistant** certification.



## COACH COMMUNICATION



- Coach updates by text.
- Coaches will receive an email invitation to the GSSA Coaches group.
- GSSA will use TeamSnap to make timely announcements - including rainouts - and provide an easy-to-access calendar of GSSA events.
- Service is FREE, but coaches must add their cell phone number in TeamSnap to receive text messages.
- Coaches can register on desktop or download the TeamSnap mobile device app.

## UNIFORMS AND EQUIPMENT



#### UNIFORMS (U4-U8)

- Parents purchase uniforms through online vendor store to be shipped directly to the player.
- New players order a club style kit that includes 2 jerseys (home/away) with player number, one black socks, one black short.
- Players wear uniforms as long as they fit and re-order each season only as needed.
- Player numbers do not matter.





#### UNIFORMS (U9-U19)

- Parents purchase uniforms through online vendor store to be shipped directly to the player.
- New players order a club style kit that includes 2 jerseys (home/away) with player number, one black socks, one black short.
- Players wear uniforms as long as they fit and re-order each season only as needed.
- Every player on a team will have a unique number. Players can request a number, but number assignment is ultimately up to the league.

    - Important to tell your parents, the cleats MUST be soccer cleats. Football, baseball cleats have a toe cleat which is not allowed in soccer for the safety of our players.



## BADGES AND ROSTERS



Coach badges must be worn for all practices and games it is your credential to oversee the team.



The badge demonstrates your permission to use the Grapevine and Southlake fields, at your designated practice and game times ONLY.



Badges are printed from your GotSport account. Badge covers are provided by GSSA with uniform distribution.



Only players on an OFFICIAL team roster can play. Take an official roster to every game.

## SCHEDULING AND RESCHEDULING GAMES

## SCHEDULING AND CONFLICTS U4-U8


- Schedules will be available on the GSSA website on the Game Day tab and are subject to change due to weather and other conflicts. Please check your schedule weekly.
- Coaches are responsible for checking the schedules for rescheduled games and notifying their team.
- GSSA advises the use of TeamSnap to communicate with your team.
- Rescheduled games will be on Sundays or weeknights.
- If you coach more than one team, it is your responsibility to let your AGC know. If you coach teams in both groups, you must let both of your AGCs know.
- 7 days after posting; schedules will not be able to be adjusted. YOU are responsible to confirm any conflicts and communicate to your AGCs. Please check your schedules as soon as possible as there are no guarantees conflicts can be resolved.
- Games can only be considered for rescheduling for REQUIRED school activities and REC Head Coaching conflicts.
- GSSA will work hard to avoid coaching conflicts but cannot do this 100% of the time. Please find an assistant coach for times when coaching conflicts cannot be resolved.
- Games may be rescheduled due to reported cases of COVID-19.



## RE-SCHEDULING U9+ WITH NMCSL

U9 and up play in the NORTHERN MID-CITIES SOCCER LEAGUE. GSSA has no control over the other associations in the league or their schedules. The rescheduling guidelines for NMCSL are as follows:

- 1. Each team is afforded 3 requests to be submitted to their home association no less than one week prior to the NMCSL scheduling meeting.
- 2. Once the season has been scheduled, games will not be rescheduled except for reasons of weather.
- 3. Any "special" non-weather request for a reschedule must be submitted by COMPLETING THE NMCSL RESCHEDULE REQUEST FORM in writing to their home association scheduler for consideration.
- 4. All non-weather-related game reschedule requests must be submitted to the NMCSL Reschedule Committee no later than halfway through the season.
  - By game 4 for an 8-game season or by game 5 for a 10-game season.
  - Note: Weather related reschedules will continue to be processed through the end of the season.
- 5. The NMCSL reschedule committee will determine the validity of the request and make a decision accordingly, either to Approve or Deny. The decision of the committee is final and not up for review or appeal.



# FIELD STATUS, WEATHER AND CANCELLATIONS



- GSSA field status will be posted at <u>gssasoccer.org</u> (bottom of main page and also on Game Day/Fields tab. DO NOT CALLTHE OFFICE, they have no information on field status. Please visit the website.
- Decisions regarding game field status will be made by 4 p.m. on weekdays; by 7:30 a.m. on Saturdays and by 10 a.m. on Sundays.
- For games at non-GSSA locations, check the field status of the association where the game is scheduled. Links to this information is available on the Game Day tab of the GSSA website.
- Be aware that field closure at various fields may vary from association to association. Do not assume your game is cancelled until the website says the field is CLOSED.
- ALL PARKS HAVE A NO PET POLICY.
- It is our duty as coaches and players to keep all practice and game fields clean. Pick up water bottles, wrappers, caps as warranted. If excess littering is detected, please contact <u>Nirav Assar</u> with time and place of incident and we will follow up.

## FIELD LIGHTNING DETECTION



Lightning is a severe hazard that must be taken seriously. Everyone should immediately seek shelter any time they believe lightning threatens the area, even if a signal has not been sounded.



You will be warned by the THOR GUARD LIGHTNING PREDICTION SYSTEM, which will sound one 15-second horn blast signaling the suspension of all activities.



If equipped, a strobe light will begin flashing and remain flashing until safe conditions return. YOU SHOULD IMMEDIATELY SEEK AN APPROPRIATE, SAFE SHELTER.



Activities may be resumed only after three 5-second horn blasts are sounded and the strobe stops flashing (if equipped).

# GAME PROTOCOLS FOR ALL AGE GROUPS

## GAME DAY PROTOCOLS

All players, parents and coaches, are subject to the **Code of Conduct** agreed to during registration. Improper language and abuse of players, referees, volunteers, staff, or coaches WILL NOT be tolerated.

Each player is <u>required to play</u> for 50% of the time they are at each game per NMCSL & GSSA bylaws.

You may not run up the score in any game. Any score with a differential of more than 6 will be reviewed.

No jewelry is allowed at all - no tape over earrings.

U4-U8 can have a max of 2 coaches on players' side.

U9-U19 can have a max of 3 coaches on players' side.

Kids and parents should be on opposite sides of the field.

Immediately substitute the player to avoid possibility of a red due to "dissent" and to discuss the infraction with the player. Note that a second yellow results in same penalty as red card for the player.

Multiple infractions during the season may result in disciplinary actions including sitting out games or removal from the league.

If a red card is given, in addition to the red card ejection and subsequent sit-out, the Player must attend the next game in uniform and the verification form must be completed by the referee, who will sign off on the fact that the player/coach did not participate but was present at the following game.

# PLAYER SAFETY AND MEDICAL RESOURCES

## KEEPING PLAYERS SAFE AND HEALTHY

- If you or your players are experiencing symptoms of illness, do not attend practices or games.
- Ensure players and spectators are not engaged in unsafe behavior at soccer fields.
- Heading the ball is NOT permitted at U12 and down.



- It is STRONGLY recommended that all coaches and assistant coaches complete the CDC Heads Up Course on concussion awareness and protocols.



## GAME PLAY U4/U5


- Each session will combine a 30-minute practice session followed immediately by 30 minutes of 4V4 games.

## GAME PLAY U6

- Spirit of the game: The idea is to learn how to play and be involved in the game. It IS NOT just about scoring.
- There are no goalies. Defending (no hands) is allowed, but defenders are encouraged to get into the whole game and not "camp out" in front of the goal.
- Substitutions allowed at end of quarters or for an injury
- Throw ins, goal kicks & corners are part of the game.
   Players must be allowed space to complete a restart of play.
- While there are no referees in U6, we want our players to be prepared for referees in the Fall of their U7 season.
   Please call penalties and help them learn what to expect.
- Meet with opposing coach before the game to agree on details. Games will be at Bob Jones Park.
- Shin guards are mandatory, and cleats are preferred.

## **NEW FOR U6 PLAY**

#### Throw-ins

• Play stops. The ball will be placed on the touch line where it left the field. The player will throw the ball into play from a standing position (meaning no running up to the ball).

#### Goal kicks

• Play stops. The ball will be placed on the end line near the closest goal post from where the ball went over the end line. The player will kick the ball into play from a standing position (meaning no running up to the ball).

#### Corner kicks

• Play stops. The ball will be placed at the corner on the same side of the field where the ball went over the end line. The player will kick the ball into play from a standing position (meaning no running up to the ball).


If the player performs the play incorrectly, play should stop and the player given a second chance. Play should continue after the second attempt even if the player does it incorrectly.

## GAME PLAY U7- U8

- Be mindful of behavior (coach and parents) in front of youth players and spectators.
- Substitutions allowed at end of quarters or for injury.
- Shin guards are mandatory, and cleats are preferred.
- Please be aware that slide tackling and "heading" the ball is prohibited. Do not practice this.
- U7/U8 will be played at Meadowmere Park or Bob Jones.
- Unprofessional behavior will result in A&D hearings. (ESPECIALLY COACHES).


## GAME PLAY U9 - U10



## NEW FOR U9/U10 PLAY

### **Build Out Lines**

- Used to promote playing the ball out of the back in a no pressure setting.
- When the goalkeeper has the ball, either during play or from a goal kick, the opposing team must move behind the build out line.
- The goalkeeper may then pass, throw or roll the ball to a teammate (no punting).
- Once the ball is in play, the opposing team may cross the build our line and play resumes.


## GAME PLAY U11 - U19

- Coaches must display their coach's ID card at all games! Those without ID's will be asked to leave if there are multiple coaches, and the coach will be suspended for the next game by NMCSL officials. You also must have a signed copy of your team roster at all games.
- U11 and U12 will play 9v9. Home games at Bob Jones, Meadow Mere or Oak Grove.
- U13 and older will play Home games at Bob Jones, Meadowmere or Oak Grove.
- Substitutions allowed on throw-ins, goal kicks, after a score or for injured player.
- Please be aware that "heading" the ball is prohibited for U11 and U12.
- All players U13 and older are required to have a Picture ID card (or a picture roster) available at the field for each game. These are to be presented to the referee prior to the start of the game.
- You will need to have the typed NMCSL game report filled out to hand to officials with the player cards (U13-U19) prior to being allowed to start the game.


