The pitching machine will be eliminated in the Pinto Division and will be brought down to the Shetland Division. Brandon Ladd voiced his concern and mentioned that his experience last Fall Ball Season that the coaches pitching to the kids was sloppy. Magoo mentioned that this change would be the stepping stone between the divisions. Darin Fotheringham mentioned his experience as the coach of the first Shetland All Star Team in Castroville. He stated the team had never used a pitching machine and was at a disadvantage facing the other Shetland All Star teams at the tournament and thought the new change is a good idea.

Foal Division: New division for 2017 for 4 year olds and first year 5 year olds. Basically T-Ball.

Current Events:

Fall Ball: New rules will be played. There are currently 22 players registered. 5 Bronco, 5 Mustang, 8 Pinto, and 4 Shetland. Applications have been received for 1 Pinto Head Coach, and 2 Mustang Assistant Coaches. Registration will close August 28th after evaluations. The Fall Ball Flyer will be passed out to schools once approved by District. The 3 fields at Sherwood have been approved for use on Sundays. Crushers will be contacted about Sunday morning availability. Cost for Fall Ball is \$60 and includes jersey, hat, and field time. There will be no practice. Depending on numbers, Bronco and Mustang may be combined to form a team. If there are enough players to form one Bronco Team, there is possibility to play other inter-city teams (Atascadero, Templeton, etc.)
