



Youngsville Sports Complex Park Rules 2025

- No outside food or drinks allowed inside of the facility.
- No alcohol allowed on all grounds of the sports complex.
- Personal water coolers or team water coolers with a spicket for players are allowed inside of the facility.
- **No ice chests allowed**, except 'Florida Water' for players, coaches and fans.
- All ice chests and team coolers are subject to search by security.
- No shelled products allowed inside of the facility (sunflower seeds, peanuts, etc.).
- Concessions will be available for purchase during all tournament hours.
- **NO R.V. OR CAMPER PARKING ALLOWED. Acadian Oasis RV Park is located less than ½ mile away. Please visit: www.acadianoasisrvpark.com**
- No admission fees will be charged at the gate.
- **No metal spikes allowed inside of the facility.**
- All tournament related questions should be directed to PONY directors.
- Lost and found items should be turned in to and picked up at the concession stand.
- No pets allowed inside of the facility. Pets are allowed on the walking trail when leashed.
- Tickets will be written for illegally parking in handicap parking spaces.
- Please report all issues, concerns and questions to the onsite YSC supervisor or security.
- Lightning Policy: All players, coaches, fans and other guests of the facility should immediately leave the playing fields and seek shelter, should the lightning detector sound one long horn, signaling a warning that lightning is in the area. No one will be allowed on the playing field while the lightning detector is flashing. Play will be allowed to resume when the lightning detector sounds three long horns signaling all is clear.

LIGHTNING WARNING

LIGHTNING IS A SEVERE HAZARD THAT MUST BE VIEWED SERIOUSLY. EVERYONE SHOULD IMMEDIATELY SEEK SHELTER ANYTIME THEY BELIEVE LIGHTNING THREATENS THEM. EVEN IF A SIGNAL HAS **NOT** BEEN SOUNDED.

YOU WILL BE WARNED BY OUR **THOR GUARD LIGHTNING PREDICTION SYSTEM**, WHICH SOUNDS **ONE** 15 SECOND BLAST OF THE HORN SIGNALING SUSPENSION OF ACTIVITIES (IF EQUIPPED, A STROBE LIGHT WILL BEGIN FLASHING AND REMAIN FLASHING UNTIL SAFE CONDITIONS RETURN. YOU SHOULD IMMEDIATELY SEEK AN APPROPRIATE, SAFE SHELTER.

YOU MAY RESUME ACTIVITIES AFTER **THREE** 5 SECOND BLASTS OF THE HORN ARE SOUNDED AND THE STROBE LIGHT, IF EQUIPPED, STOPS FLASHING.

IF YOU REMAIN OUTDOORS AFTER THE WARNING IS ISSUED, YOU DO SO AT YOUR OWN RISK!!!

- Large Buildings
- Lightning Shelters
- Automobiles/Trucks
- Tunnels With No Standing Water

When one of the above is not available, seek...

- Dense Woods
- Low Lying Areas

AVOID

- Open Areas
- Water
- Tall Trees
- Metal Fences
- Overhead Wires and Power Lines
- High Ground Area
- Telephones & Cellular Phones
- Radios
- Small, Unprotected Shelters
