## COACHES, MANAGERS, AND TRAINERS CODE OF CONDUCT

- \* Coaches, managers and trainers shall treat officials with respect and dignity, and shall teach their players to do the same.
- \* Coaches, managers, and trainers will model respect for opponents and expect the same from their players. They shall model grace, dignity and composure in both victory and defeat.
- \* Coaches, managers, and trainers, shall model inclusive behavior, actively supporting cultural diversity while opposing all types of discrimination, racism and sexism. They shall refrain from, nor condone all forms of personal abuse and harassment of others, whether verbal, physical, emotional or sexual.
- \* Coaches, managers, and trainers shall respect the declared affiliations of all players, and shall adhere to all guidelines and regulations on recruiting established by the governing bodies having oversight of their teams and leagues.
- \* Coaches, managers, and trainers shall seek to honor those who uphold the highest standards and principles of soccer and shall use appropriate protocol to oppose and eliminate all behavior that brings disrepute to the sport - violence, abuse, dishonesty, disrespect and violations of the Laws of the Game and rules governing competition.

Violation of this Code of Conduct could result in disciplinary proceedings up to and including verbal or written warning from Fort Wayne Sport Club Youth Board for a first offense, and vote of the Fort Wayne Sport Club on suspension or termination of duty for a second offense.

Coaches are expected to make sure that their players, parents and spectators are aware of and adhere to club, league, state and other governing bodies Code of Conduct. Issues that need brought to the Fort Wayne Sport Club Youth Board's attention should be done so immediately.
