I, _____ am being engaged by the Greater Libertyville Soccer Association (GLSA), a not-for-profit youth soccer organization, to work as a referee in the GLSA youth soccer program. I have already completed the referee education course offered by GLSA or a certification course offered by the United States Soccer Federation (USSF), and understand the role of serving as a youth referee. I understand that a parent or guardian must supervise 12 and 13 year old referees during the games.

The GLSA recreational league consists of an 8-week season in fall and a 6-week season in spring. Games are played on weekends. I may be assigned to referee a minimum of 1 game to a maximum of 4 games on game days during each season. Game lengths run between 30 minutes and up to 60 minutes, depending on the player's age group. Occasionally, I may be assigned to referee a weeknight "make-up" game - such an assignment would not exceed one game per night. I will only be assigned to games in which I will be at least 3 years older than the players.

Referees with appropriate experience and USSF certification may be assigned as an assistant referee under the direction of an adult referee in Illinois Youth Soccer Association league games. My total assignments will not exceed ten hours per week nor will any assignment occur after 9:00PM.

I am requesting a work permit, which is required by the Illinois Department of Labor (820 ILCS 205), to allow me to work as a youth referee for GLSA. I am submitting this letter, along with a copy of my birth certificate, and social security card to my school to process the request for the permit.
