## **Rec All-Star Frequently Asked Questions:**

What age groups can play in the Tournament? Rec players from our U8, U10, U12, U14, and High School divisions are all eligible to play. However, teams will only be formed if there are enough players in a given age group. All decisions on player selections and team formations by the CSC Technical Staff are final.

Do tryouts cost money? No, tryouts are FREE! Players MUST be registered to try out. Use this link to register your player: Click Here

If my player gets selected, how much does it cost? Registration for Rec All-Stars is \$95 or \$110 depending on the age group.

Do they get a jersey? Yes a jersey is included with the registration price. However, the player will be responsible for the black shorts and black socks.

When and where is the Tournament? The tournament is being hosted by Herndon Youth Soccer. Exact field locations and game times will be announced closer to the tournament.

How many games do they play? Games within this Tournament will consist of two rounds: Qualification and Championship. The Qualification Round is formatted into mini games. Each team will play 4 mini games on Saturday. All games in the Qualification Round will consist of 2 halves of 12 minutes each playing time. There will be a 1 minute halftime during which the referee will have the teams change ends of the field. The Championship Round is formatted into full games. Each team will play at least one full game on Sunday. U9 through U12: Two (2) 25-minute halves with a 5-minute intermission. U13 through U19: Two (2) 30-minute halves with a 5-minute intermission. All U8 games will be Qualification Round games. Each U8 team will play 7 mini games, 3 on one day and 4 on the other.
