BMYBL COACHES CONDUCT CLAUSE

The coach must be aware that he can be either a positive or a negative influence upon the development of the athlete. In all of his personal contacts with athletes, officials, parents, the media, and the public, the coach shall strive to set an example of the highest ethical and moral conduct. In keeping with that goal, the following ethical guidelines should be observed by all BMYBL coaches:

- The coach shall never place the value of winning above the value of instilling the highest desirable ideals of character.
- The coach must always consider the personal safety of the athlete.
- The coach shall be thoroughly acquainted with the rules and regulations of competition, and shall be
 responsible for their interpretation to team members. The coach shall not try to seek an advantage by
 circumventing the spirit or letter of the rules.
- Game officials shall have the respect and support of the coach. The coach shall not indulge in conduct
 which will incite the players or spectators against the officials. Public criticism of the officials or players
 is unethical.
- The coach should respect his opponents, display gracious behavior during competition and require his
 players to conduct themselves in similar fashion. Before and after the contest, rival coaches should
 meet and exchange friendly greetings to set the correct tone for the event.
- · Coaches shall actively use their influence to enhance sportsmanship by spectators.
- The coach must recognize the importance of the athlete's academic development and promote the proper balance between athletic and academic activities.
