ATTENTION PARENTS: HEART SCREENING SEPTEMBER 28

On **September 28th**, "Who We Play For" will be present to complete heart screens for students between **9 AM** and **3 PM**. If you are interested in having your athlete screened the cost is \$20 per athlete. Walk-ins are welcome, a hard copy consent form will need to be filled out. To make things easier and faster, you may pre-register your athlete at https://www.whoweplayfor.org/screening. This is open to students in the community, not just soccer players at TSC. Students ages 10 and up, can be scanned, however, 12 and up is the preferred age range.

Screening Procedure: Each screen takes about ten minutes to complete, and even less time if the athlete is pre-registered with us. Male and female screens will be separated to provide privacy for the female athletes. Female athletes would need to be in a sports-bra or to raise their shirt up to the bottom of where a sports-bra would be. This allows access to place the leads required for the ECG. The test is completely pain-less and non-invasive. All ECGs are then sent electronically to their pediatric cardiologist who will interpret them.

Follow-Up: Roughly 3 to 7 days after the screening, their pediatric cardiologist will return the results. All screens will be placed in one of three categories: low-risk (no follow up needed), follow-up (abnormality found but not of high risk), high-risk (significant abnormality requiring expedited evaluation). The results will be communicated directly to the families using the contact information that we receive from their consent forms.

REFEREE INFORMATION FOR COACHES AND SPECTATORS

There are occasional times when referees at our club, and throughout the country, experience referee abuse and even assault. Because our club is an affiliate of the Florida Youth Soccer Association (FYSA) we must have an official Referee Assignor (who must be trained and recertify each year) and we may only use contract state certified referees through the Florida Referee Association. Minimum age is 13. All referees go through training and certification, in additional to risk management background checks. They must recertify each year. Some referees are more "seasoned" than others, regardless of age, and experience belligerent comments, unfortunate obscene language, in addition to hurtful comments (in this case, it is often because of inadequate knowledge of the game, which is human). What is also human are the referees. Sometimes they make mistakes. Please keep the children in mind if you have frustrations and wait until the game is over to speak to our Head Referee/Assignor, Grant Aleman. Referee abuse/assault is a serious matter that your club would rather not have to address. We also have Site Directors (listed in each week's Striker newsletter) if you have concerns during a game.

Concession and Field Duty Requirements

Concession duty and Field duty are required by each team, once a season. Often times, this duty is forgotten or the team manager is unable to get a volunteer. When we do not get our volunteers, it is a burden on our Board Members to get the job done alone. In case you don't know, Field Duty only takes about 45 minutes each Friday night if we get enough volunteers. This involves lining the fields and placing the flags on the corners. Concession duty is only an hour and a half and only involves serving food and snow cones (no cash register). Concession is nearly impossible to run without help. So, next time your team manager asks for volunteers, please consider raising your hand and helping out. It's always a fun experience!
