Scholarships available:

\$1,500 scholarship (2)

Eligibility:

Graduating high school seniors who meet the following criteria:

- Past or present involvement in Eden Prairie Soccer Club (either a player and/or referee).
 High School soccer experience is not required.
- Soccer volunteer commitment
- Community volunteer commitment
- High standard of personal conduct
- Leadership qualities
- Academic achievement

Application:

- Complete the application by deadline **February 15, 2019.**
- Answer the essay question
- Obtain two letters of recommendation
- Send completed packet via email to scholarship@epsoccerclub.com

Scholarship Selection Procedure

- Evaluation by selection committee of submitted applications resulting in up to eight finalists
- Invite up to eight finalists to a 20-minute personal interview with the selection committee.
- Notification will be sent to all applicants and finalists regarding the final decision

Scholarship Presentation:

- Present scholarships at the EPHS Academic Awards night
- Arrangements for winners from other high schools will be made on a school-by-school basis
- Award recipients agree to take a group photo for media publication

Eden Prairie Soccer Scholarship Essay Overview

The goal of this easy section is to get to know you better. The committee is focused on the *content* and *quality* of your essay. Please reference the essay number instead of writing out each question. Limit your answer to two – three paragraphs. On a separate sheet of paper, submit your response to the following essay question:

- 1. Share a few soccer lessons, skills or coaching advice you have found helpful in your personal life.
- 2. Describe why soccer is important to you. Examples of areas to write about are:
 - a. Soccer background
 - b. Personal accomplishments
 - c. Most memorable experience
 - d. Most difficult or successful aspects of the game

Letters of Recommendation:

- 1. Obtain two letters of recommendation
 - a. Base recommendation letters on any or all of the criteria in the eligibility section.
 - Letters from your parents, EPSC Board of Directors, EPSC Director of Coaching, EPSC Assistant Director of Coaching, or the Eden Prairie Soccer scholarship committee are not allowed.
 - c. Limit letters to one page per recommendation.
