

Wheatland Athletic Association Oswego East High School 2024 Scholarship Application

Scholarship Eligibility Requirements

Wheatland Athletic Association, WAA, will award up to two \$500 scholarships to eligible Oswego East High School graduating seniors. To be eligible for the Wheatland Athletic Association scholarship, applicants must have participated in a Wheatland Athletic Association program, either as an athlete, student worker or volunteer. A short essay is required addressing the benefits of participation with WAA and your goals for the future. The Wheatland Athletic Association's Board of Directors will review all applications.

Scholarships will be awarded based on WAA participation and the student essay with additional consideration of student achievements. Monetary awards will be given to students who have been accepted at any accredited college, university or vocational/technical school. Awards are one time only and are not renewable. Scholarships will be paid to the individual winners and must be utilized for educational expenses during the 2024-2025 school year. WAA will notify the Oswego East High School Guidance Department/College and Career Center of recipients. Awards will be distributed at the annual Senior Awards Assembly.

- II. Written statement (500 words or less)
