

## Warren County Soccer Club Parent Code of Conduct

Warren County Soccer Club (WCSC) has implemented the following Parent Code of Conduct outlining the proper role of parents within our organization. WCSC will make every effort possible to ensure that all players have a fun and educational soccer experience with a focus on Respect, Fair Play and Sportsmanship. We ask that parents take the time to review and understand the items below and return the signed copy to your Head Coach, confirming that have you read and understand the Code of Conduct, before the first game of the season.

Please help us educate your children and keep soccer fun for all of our players.

- I will encourage good sportsmanship by being a positive role model.
- I (and my guests) will be a positive role model for all players by showing respect and courtesy to players, coaches, officials and all spectators at every game, practice, and other club events.
- I will try my best to make athletics a positive and safe experience for everyone involved, i.e., participants, coaches, officials, and spectators.
- I will insist my player treat other players, coaches, officials, and fans with respect.
- I will be a "team" fan, not a "my child" fan.
- I will help my child learn that winning and losing is not the only measure of success.
- I will teach my child that doing one's best is more important than winning, so that my child will never feel defeated by the outcome of a game or his/her performance.
- I will remember that children participate to have fun and that the game is for youth, not adults.
- I will applaud good plays by our team AND by members of the opposing team.
- I will allow the coach to coach, the referee to officiate, and most of all allow the players to play the game.
- I will accept the results of each game, and encourage my child to be humble in victory, gracious in defeat, and to turn lessons from each into opportunities for improvement.
- I (and my guests) will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any official, coach, player, or parent such as booing and taunting, using profane language or gestures.
- I will never ridicule or yell at my child or other players for making a mistake or losing a competition.
- I will respect and obey the rules of the park/stadium/field.
- If I have a concern, I will talk to the coach at the appropriate time and place, i.e., never before, during, or immediately after a contest.
