The Fall Baseball program will focus on sharpening general baseball skills and fundamentals, while still allowing for competitive play. The league is great because it provides an opportunity for players to transition into their new age group prior to the upcoming 2020 Spring League. It's also great for newcomers because of the leagues focus on fundamentals. Each league will play approximately 10 games and a season ending tournament.

FAQ:

What equipment/uniform pieces are provided and what equipment is needed?

- **Equipment**: Each team will be given an assortment of equipment including bats, balls, helmets and catcher equipment suitable for the age group your child is in. Gloves should be purchased by the parent as they are not provided.
- **Uniform Pieces**: Each child will be provided with their team shirt, hats and socks. Sizing is generally done in the beginning of the season when teams first meet. Other uniform equipment such as cleats, batting gloves, undershirt chest protectors and pants are purchased separately by parents. (color of pants will be communicated with parents when team assignments are made.)

How many days a week does the league practice?

- Optional Practice is generally done 1 time a week M-F at one of the local fields. Weather conditions and or scheduling issues may effect this throughout the season. It is recommended your child attend as many as possible to get the full experience of the season. This is the time kids will learn the appropriate skills used in their league. Game day while it is instructional is the day children implement the skill they learned in practice.

Refund Policy

- The S.P.O.R.T.S. processing fee that is included in participant registration fees is non-refundable.
Refunds will be given (less the non-refundable fee) through May 31, the end of the open registration period.
Participants who sustain an injury prior to the start of the season will only be granted a refund with supporting documentation from a physician. If documentation from a physician is not provided, no refund will be given. Any injury that occurs during the season does not qualify for a refund of any amount.
At the conclusion of the open registration period, all other refunds will occur based on the below schedule:
May 1 - June 15 - Refund after \$32 non-refundable fee is subtracted
June 16 - July 15 - 50% refund after \$32 non-refundable fee is subtracted
July 16 - July 31 - 25% refund after \$32 non-refundable fee is subtracted
After July 31 - No refund
The \$10 late fee for registrations after May 31 is also non-refundable
