Program Overview

Fall ball provides an opportunity for players to transition into their new age group prior to the upcoming 2026 spring season. Each division will play approximately 10-12 games and a season ending tournament. The format is similar to the spring season, but play will be more limited in frequency.

Registration Fees

Open fall registration will be held during the month of May 2025. Registration will be accepted online at myathletics.com. Fall fees (early bird pricing) will be as follows:

- \$130: 7U – 15U

There will be a multi-player discount available for families registering three or more children. Early bird pricing will be available during the month of May. Beginning June 1st, registration fees will increase.

Fall 2025 Divisions

League Practices

Optional practices may be offered once a week, M-F, at a local field within the HSE School District. Weather conditions and/or scheduling issues may affect this throughout the season. It is recommended your child attend as many practices as possible to get the full experience of the season.

Equipment Overview

Each team will be given an assortment of equipment including bats, balls, helmets, and catcher equipment suitable for the age group your participant is in. Gloves should be purchased by the parent/guardian as they are not provided. Players who use their own bats must follow league bat guidelines: Effective Spring 2021 ALL players MUST use USA certified bats for rec play. **USSSA bats are not permitted.** A link to approved bats can be found here usabat.com.

Uniform Pieces

Each child will receive a team shirt, hat, and socks. Sizing is generally done in the beginning of the season when teams first meet. Other uniform equipment such as cleats, batting gloves, undershirt chest protectors and pants should be purchased separately by parent/guardian (color of pants will be communicated when team assignments are made). The league recommends purchasing white and gray and then returning whichever color your team doesn't select.

Refund Policy

For the fall 2025 season, the refund policy will be as follows:

May 1 – June 15th – Refund after \$44 non-refundable fee

June 16th – July 15th – 50% refund after the \$44 non-refundable fee

July 16th – July 31st – 25% refund after the \$44 non-refundable fee

After July 31st – No refund

Any additional fees incurred for registration completed after May 31st are also non-refundable.

*Participants who sustain an injury prior to the start of the season will only be granted a refund with supporting documentation from a physician. If documentation from a physician is not provided, no refund will be given. Any injury that occurs during the season does not qualify for a refund of any amount.

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
