The Mudsock Youth Cheer recreational league is open to cheerleaders in grades K-6th grade. The cheer squads support the 4th grade and 5th/6th grade tackle divisions of the youth football league during the fall football season. The league is designed to teach sideline cheer skills that participants can build on throughout their years in the youth cheer program.

Registration Fees

Open registration for fall will be held during the month of May 2026. Registration will be accepted online at myathletics.com. Fall fees will be as follows:

- **Kindergarten – 6th grade**
 - **\$200 including uniform**
 - **Due to supply issues with the previous uniform, a new style will be adopted this season. All participants will be required to obtain a new uniform this season.*

Beginning June 1st, registration fees will increase and the league may close registration or move divisions to a waitlist at any time. There will be a multi-player discount available for families registering three or more children.

Refund Policy

For the fall 2026 season, the refund policy will be as follows:

May 1st – June 15th – Refund after \$50 non-refundable fee

June 16th – July 15th – 50% refund after the \$50 non-refundable fee

July 16th – July 31st – 25% refund after the \$50 non-refundable fee

After July 31st – No refund

Any additional fees incurred for registration completed after May 31st are also non-refundable.

Season Overview

The cheer season runs from August through October. Participants selected to cheer as part of the All-Star Program will continue practicing through early November. Please note that the cheer schedule is based on the Mudsock Youth Football schedule. Information will be released once the football drafts are completed in late July.

Practices/Games

Practices will take place on Thursdays for 1 hour or less, anywhere from 5:30p-8:00p, depending on the coach's schedule. Practices are primarily at Cumberland Road Elementary, and games are at Mudsock Fields. Most games occur on Saturdays, with occasional weeknight games to account for the Labor Day holiday weekend, when no games will be played, weather make-up games, and playoffs.

Uniforms

Please note that uniforms are included with your registration. Please use the size guide below to order the size of uniform you wish your child to receive. Uniforms, bows, and poms will be distributed at the first practice. If your child's uniform does not fit correctly, please work with other parents for a possible trade. The Cheer Board will have a limited number of extra uniforms that can be swapped on a first-come, first served basis in cases where the uniform is unwearable due to size miscalculations.

Chest: Measure under your arms, around the fullest part of your chest.

Waist: Measure at your natural waistline, just below your belly button.

Hips: Measure around the fullest part of your body.

FAQs

Who do the squads cheer for?

Squads cheer for the Mudsock Youth Football 4th, 5th, and 6th grade tackle teams. Please note, we DO NOT currently cheer for flag football or 3rd grade teams.

Who are the coaches?

We rely on parent volunteers, like other Mudsock Youth Athletics leagues. We ask those one or more parents/guardians, volunteer to coach/co-coach a squad. You DO NOT need cheer experience! The Cheer Board gives all coaches the tools they need to help the participants be successful throughout the season.

What skills should my child have before starting Mudsock Youth Cheer?

Absolutely none! Volunteer coaches will teach all cheers and skills needed for sideline rec league cheer. There is absolutely no stunting allowed and each cheerleader must always have one foot on the ground. Cheerleaders with prior training in gymnastics or tumbling may, with parent permission and supervision, do occasional cartwheels, roundoffs, or flips. There are absolutely no partner stunts or lifts allowed.

Do coaches receive discounted registration fees?

We do not offer discounted registration fees for coaches.

Do you accept sibling or team requests?

You may include a request in the comments section of your online registration form at myathletics.com. To be considered, the request must include the name and relationship of the football player, cheerleader, or coach with whom you would like to be placed. Please note, we do not guarantee requests. The only requests that we can ensure are siblings and parent/guardians coaching (football/cheer). If we can honor any friend requests, it will be mandatory that one or more parents/guardians volunteer to coach/co-coach.

What is the waitlist?

Mudsock Youth Cheer tries to ensure all participants have the best experience possible; therefore, we are limiting the size of the squads so that each child has visibility, coaching, and time in front of the fans. If the waitlist results in enough potential participants, the Mudsock Youth Cheer Board may consider creating squads to cheer for 3rd grade tackle football as well provided there are enough volunteer coaches. Priority will be given to waitlisted participants who have a parent/guardian who is willing to coach a squad.

What if my participant is selected as an All-Star?

Coaches will select athletes to cheer for the All-Star football teams, which play in October and November. There is an additional charge to participate as an All-Star, approximately \$60. All-Star tournaments will be chosen by the Mudsock Youth Football board. If chosen for All-Star, you are guaranteed one tournament, but your team could participate in two depending upon the football team and availability of the coaches.
