2026 Mudsock Boys Lacrosse Program Overview

Youth lacrosse offers an incredible opportunity for kids to develop valuable skills both on and off the field as part of a league. As a fast-paced, team-oriented sport, lacrosse fosters physical fitness, hand-eye coordination, and strategic thinking while emphasizing teamwork, communication, and discipline. Being part of a league allows players to build lasting friendships, gain a sense of belonging, and experience the camaraderie of working toward shared goals. Whether your athlete is new to the sport or looking to refine their skills, youth lacrosse provides a supportive environment that encourages personal growth, resilience, and a lifelong love for the game.

Our Mudsock Boys Lacrosse program offers players from 1st through 8th grade an opportunity to play as part of the Indiana Youth Lacrosse Association (IYLA) with games against teams from throughout Central Indiana. In addition, our 10U, 12U, and 14U players are offered opportunities to play some in-season tournaments against teams from throughout the Midwest.

Most teams will begin practices in March, while the 12UA and 14UA teams will begin practices in January. Games will begin in mid to late March and run through the State IYLA tournament in mid to late May for our 10U, 12U, and 14U teams. Our 8U teams will play in a variety of jamboree type events along with some individual games. Games are typically played during the week and some weekends.

Our 12UA and 14UA team coaches will strive to give all players playing time on the field but can't guarantee equal playing time. All other teams will attempt to provide equal playing time.

Age Eligibility Rules Update from IYLA: Starting in 2024, players with a birthdate between June 1st and September 1st will have the option to play down with others in their grade or choose to play within the divisions as listed above. For more information, you can consult the USA Lacrosse Age Group Chart.

Please note, continued for 2026, the Mudsock Boys Lacrosse program, for age groups 12U and 14U, will continue the team designations of: an A team and B team. The team divisions will help our league better align with the designations of other area IYLA teams we compete against. Evaluations for team placement was completed in the fall of 2025 for the 2026 season. Players who did not participate in the evaluations in the fall of 2025 will be evaluated as practices begin in 2026 and placed on appropriate teams at that time. For our 10U players, an evaluation will be held in March once practices begin to align teams based on skills and experience to ensure competitive alignment with other programs we will compete against during the season.

Registration Fees

Open spring registration will be held during the month of January 2026. Registration will be accepted online at www.myathletics.com. Spring fees (early bird pricing) will be as follows:

- 8U = \$150 (includes uniform and all spring practices and games)
- 10U = \$250 (includes uniform, indoor practices at Mojo Up Sports Complex, and all spring practices and games)
- 12U-B = \$300 (includes uniform, indoor practices at Mojo Up Sports Complex, 2 tournaments, and all spring practices and games)
- 14U-B = \$400 (includes uniform, indoor practices at Mojo Up Sports Complex, 3 tournaments, and all spring practices and games.)
- 12U-A & 14U-A = \$450 (includes uniform, indoor practices at Mojo Up Sports Complex, 3 tournaments, and all spring practices and games.)

There will be a multi-player discount available for families registering three or more children. Early bird pricing will be available during the month of January. Beginning February 1st, registration fees will increase, and waitlists may begin forming at any time.

Note: The 10U team(s) may have the opportunity to join one or more tournaments, with additional fees collected only from those players who choose to participate.

USA Lacrosse Membership

All players must also have a valid USA Lacrosse membership card/number (available at uslacrosse.org (cost is \$35)) to complete your registration and play.

Refunds

January 1 – February 15 – Refund after \$50 non-refundable is subtracted. February 16 – March 15 – 50% refund after \$50 non-refundable is subtracted. March 16 – March 31 – 25% refund after \$50 non-refundable is subtracted. After March 31 – No refund.

Participants who sustain an injury prior to the start of the season will only be granted a refund with supporting documentation from a physician. If documentation from a physician is not provided, no refund will be given. Any injury that occurs during the season does not qualify for a refund of any amount.

Where will the sessions be held?

Mojo Up Sports Complex (formerly Finch Creek Fieldhouse) at 16289 Boden Road in Noblesville for indoor practices; January through early-March.

Hamilton Proper Park at the southeast corner of 116th St. and Hoosier Rd. in Fishers for outdoor practices; March-May.

Home games will be at Cyntheanne Park; 12383 Cyntheanne Road, Fishers, 46037.

How can I volunteer?

Our league's success is built on the dedication of the men and women who volunteer each season. This year, especially if we host the IYLA State Tournament for the 5th year in a row, we will need over 200 volunteer roles filled to keep everything running smoothly. Tasks include preparing practice and game fields, keeping time and score, providing snacks and drinks, supporting fundraisers, coaching, and more. Thanks to our amazing volunteers, we've avoided requiring parents/guardians to either volunteer or pay extra fees like other leagues. However, as we reach out for help this season, we ask that you find a way to contribute your time, talent, or resources. Without sufficient support, we may need to explore fundraising options to compensate for paid help.

Summer Playing Opportunities

Our "CATS" program has traditionally offered opportunities for players to continue playing in the summer to enhance skills and get valuable playing time. The Summer of 2025 will be no exception. For those who are interested in playing, we will look to field a team with playing options for our 10U division for at least two tournaments in the summer across June and July. Locations are all within easy driving distance of the Fishers area. The cost would be collected later in the season and would be \$300 or less, depending on the number of players who commit. We do plan to avoid any potential scheduling conflicts with local club teams who are also participating in summer tournaments. Actual tournaments will be decided in the February timeframe.

What gear do I need?

Players are required to attend in full gear which includes a helmet, shoulder pads, elbow pads, gloves, mouthguard, stick and a protective cup. For all field players, as of January 1, 2022, all players are required to have updated shoulder pads designed for lacrosse and to meet NOCSAE standard ND200. For details on equipment, click here.
