# **Out of District Waivers**

For those applying for "Out of District" waivers, all divisions will be assessed after early registration closes on February 1, 2026 and requests will be assessed on an individual basis and in accordance with Indiana Youth Lacrosse Association's requirements and Mudsock Youth Athletics' waiver procedure.

# **Registration Fees**

Open Spring registration will be held during the month of January 2026. Registration will be accepted online at www.myathletics.com. Spring fees (early bird pricing) will be as follows:

- \$100 8U (registration fee includes a Mudsock Lacrosse Shirt and Shorts).
- \$230\*-10U, 12U, 14U (registration fee includes a Mudsock Lacrosse Jersey, Shirt, and Shorts).
   \*The increase includes individual player jerseys that will be applicable for 2 seasons. Jerseys are anticipated to be bought on "even" years. Meaning: the jersey bought in 2026 will be for the 2026 season and 2027 season; new jerseys are anticipated to be bought in 2028. Players will keep their jersey at the end of each season. The board will not be collecting a uniform deposit as it has done in the past.

There will be a multi-player discount available for families registering three or more children. Early bird pricing will be available during the month of January. **To ensure you receive your jersey on time and preferred size, please sign up by January 31st.** Beginning February 1st, registration fees will increase, and waitlists may begin forming at any time.

#### Refunds

January 1-February 15 – Refund after \$50 non-refundable fee is subtracted. February 16-March 15 – 50% refund after \$50 non-refundable fee is subtracted. March 16-March 31 - 25% refund after \$50 non-refundable fee is subtracted. After March 31 - No refund.

Participants who sustain an injury prior to the start of the season will only be granted a refund with supporting documentation from a physician. If documentation from a physician is not provided, no refund will be given. Any injury that occurs during the season does not qualify for a refund of any amount.

## **Deposits**

A \$100 volunteer deposit for **each family (not per player)** will be collected at the start of the season. Deposits checks will be destroyed once the family volunteer hour requirement (3 hours per family) is fulfilled. Volunteer opportunities are exclusive to coaching and the state tournament. Athletes will not be able to participate in games until the board receives the volunteer check.

#### **Season Information**

Indoor practices have already been scheduled at Precision Fieldhouse at Finch Creek (formerly known as Mojo-Up) in Noblesville. In order to participate in the indoor practices, athletes must be registered and have an active USA Lacrosse number.

8U outdoor practices begin when city of Fishers opens fields in the spring. (End of March)

10U & 12U indoor practices:

- 2/2 & 2/9: 7:30-8:30P
- 2/23: 5:30-6:30P
- 3/2, 3/9, 3/16 & 3/23: 5-6P

#### 14U indoor practices:

- 1/19: 6-7P
- 2/2, 2/9, 2/23: 8:30-9:30P
- 2/5, 2/12, 2/19, 2/26: 5-6P
- 3/2, 3/9, 3/16 & 3/23: 7-8P
- 3/4, 3/11, 3/18, 3/25: 8-9P

Regular season (outdoor practices and games) starts last week of March and runs through the end of May.

- Practices will either be at Cyntheanne Park or Hamilton Proper Park.
- Home games will be at Cyntheanne Park.
- 10U, 12U and 14U will have ~ 1-2 practices a week for ~ 1.5 hours and 8-10 games per season.
- There will be some city-wide travel (Brownsburg, Westfield, etc.) for away games.
- Most games will be held on Wednesday and Friday evenings or Sunday afternoons.
- IYLA State Tournament is scheduled for May 16th at Cyntheanne Park.
