




This guide will take you through all of the steps to be compliant with LL Intl., District 57, and Bollinger Canyon Little League to be able to participate as a coach this season. All of these trainings should be completed before practices begin February 1, 2026 however, we are giving you a grace period to have them completed by February 15, 2026.

- 1) Go to www.littleleague.org
- 2) At the top right find and click on "Coaches"
