Overview	To ensure all <u>eligible</u> players (7-8 th grade) get a minimum number of plays in each game based on team size.
Policy	All <u>eligible</u> players (7-8 th grade) shall participate in a minimum of 5 plays each game.
Policy Guidelines	
Eligibility	<p>A 7-8th grade eligible player is a player that exhibits, at a minimum, all of the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Participated in a minimum of 10 practices (20 hours) including 3 practices (6 hours) helmets only prior to their first game. • Absences during the week prior to the game: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ 1 absence (unexcused) = the player is not eligible to be a starter.
Rules	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Plays must be from the line of scrimmage. 2. The play must be an active, forward moving play, with no penalties as a result. 3. If a player is injured before completing the minimum plays, it should be noted on the MPR form that they became injured and placed in the team book for reference.
Tracking	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Head Coach is accountable for compliance with all MPR rules.
Consequences	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The following are the consequences for coaches not adhering to this MPR policy. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ 1st Occurrence: If player(s) do not get their minimum plays in a game, the head coach will meet with the director of coaching to discuss the reason(s). ○ 2nd Occurrence: The head coach will meet with the executive board. ○ 3rd Occurrence: The head coach will be suspended for the next game. Further violations may result in other game/season suspensions.
