CC Fundamentals of Baseball Summer Camp: Managed by retired coach Rick Prieto. Coach Prieto has managed this neighborhood baseball camp for almost 30 years. His baseball knowledge and experiences are, in part, due to playing high school (CCHS Alumnus), college, and pro baseball in Mexico.

Camp coaches include the varsity head coach, and current and former CCHS varsity baseball players. The camp covers the basics skills in throwing, catching, fielding, hitting, bunting, base running, and instructional scrimmages. The low Coach/Player ratio ensures that each player will receive personal attention while having fun improving their baseball skills.

Balance to be paid by June 16<sup>th</sup>. No refunds for cancellations after **June 12th.**
