I hereby pledge to have a positive attitude and be responsible for my actions by following the Richland National Little League Player Code of Conduct:

- 1. I will take responsibility for my own behavior and success, including my relationships with teammates, umpires, RNLL volunteers, and the coaching staff.
- 2. I will respect all aspects of the game, including myself, coaches, officials, teammates, opponents, volunteers, fans and rules, regardless of the behavior of others.

- 4. I recognize that I am representing Richland National Little League and I will act accordingly, including being humble in victory and gracious in defeat.
- 5. I will encourage good sportsmanship from fellow players, coaches, officials, opponents, parents and fans at every game and practice.

- 7. I will not display or promote unsafe actions or disorderly conduct during practices or games.
- 8. I will not use improper language.
- 9. I will not use or possess alcohol, tobacco, or any non-prescribed drug.
