COACHES please note all coaches require Safe Sport certification and a background check with USAW. This is a requirement to coach matside at all ISWA State Tournaments. **USAW Wrestling Leader Cards.** You'll now be able to see all certification levels on your membership cards (Copper = C, Bronze = B, Silver = S, Gold = G). USAW will no longer be sending cards that are copper, bronze, silver or gold in color. Coaches working toward Silver or Gold status to have completed both Copper and Bronze certifications before starting advanced levels. This is designed to help coaches improve recruitment and retention of athletes at all ages of development
