





Local League Rules T-Ball

(Updated 2022)

Overview of T-Ball Rules & Regulations

- 1. Coaches will be given a tee and 6 baseballs. League helmets will be provided and must be worn during games.
- 2. Every player is in the batting order.
- 3. Every player bats one time per inning.
- 4. Games will last until each team gets a minimum three at bats or a total of 60 minutes. If time allows, play another inning.
- 5. After the batting team's entire lineup has batted, they must switch with the team in the field. Last batter runs all the bases until he/she crosses home plate.
- 6. The batter does not swing until the coach sees that all players are ready and says "Batter Up!".
- 7. No bunting, stealing, leading off, or advancing bases on overthrows and missed cutoffs.
- 8. The batted ball must travel outside the half moon or it will be called a foul ball. No strikeouts or walks.
- 9. The coach will be the catcher. There will be 6 infielders: 2 pitchers, first base, second base, shortstop, and third base. The rest of the players will be in the outfield. Outfielders must play infield during the next inning.
- 10. Teams will play with the orange safety base.
- 11. On defense, coaches will be out in the field instructing players on what to do. On offense, coaches will be in the coaching box instructing their runners.
- 12. When you are the last game or last practice... Please put away bases and rake field.
- 13. When in doubt, use common sense to keep players safe and give them the opportunity to play.
