Player League Age

- Little League[®] and Georgia aligned on August 31st age cutoff
 - Grade and League Age should now align
 - For example, 6th graders would be League Age 12
 - This assumes a child was not held back and didn't start school late
- This pushes some players into a new League Age
 - Example: Joey was born on July 4, 2005
 - In our current system, Joey is League Age 12
 - 7th Grader playing with mostly 6th Graders
 - In Little League[®] system, Joey would be League Age 13

All-Stars

- Player can play based on League Age...regardless of League played in
- Teams will still play local tournaments against local competition
- Opportunities to play in Little League[®] sanctioned tournaments
- Same timeframe as current All-Star season until Major Division
 - Chance to play on ESPN in Little League[®] World Series





Other Things to Consider

- Online Registration will provide more details about each league to help families determine which league is right for them
- Registration Fees will remain the same
- Residency Requirements do exist
 - All Hobgood Families can remain at Hobgood regardless of residence
- New League format will begin in Fall 2018 season
