Each Region team that applies for participation in the Kirk Banks Tournament **shall provide at least one certified and qualified referee crew consisting of 3 qualified referees** to fulfill their teams' tournament referee assignments. Each referee team will be asked to officiate a minimum of 3 games during the tournament. Assignments may consist of field assignments or standby assignments. (Yes, you still need to check-in for stand-by assignments.) The referee deposit of \$300 will be refunded at the end of the tournament under the conditions fulfilled and listed below. A partial refund is also possible.

## All referees participating in the 2024 Kirk Banks Tournament must:

- Be registered as AYSO volunteers in the current membership year.
- Be AYSO Safe Haven certified.
- Have completed AYSO Concussion Awareness or HCAMP Brainspace training for MY2023
- Have completed AYSO Sudden Cardiac Arrest training
- Have completed SafeSport Training for MY2023
- <u>Check-in in full uniform as defined by AYSO and USSF</u>, i.e. appropriate referee jersey, solid black shorts, 2 or 3-stripe referee socks and referee certification badge. The Gold uniform will be considered the primary color of referee uniform for this tournament. The referee crew will be expected to change to an alternate color in case of conflict with either team playing in the game.
- Referees should hold the following minimum certifications:

All referees must check-in at the respective age-group tent, in full referee uniform (see above), at least 30 minutes, but no later than 15 minutes, before their scheduled assignment, in order to receive credit for the game. Referee teams may fail to get credit (or lose part or all of their referee deposit), at the discretion of the Tournament Referee Administrator, for the following reasons: if any member of the team checks in late (10 minutes before game time), is not properly dressed, or is not certified to referee. While every effort will be made to keep referee teams together, there may be instances where The Tournament Referee Administrator or designated representative will split up referee teams or send teams to other games at the same time period. Please be flexible as we seek to provide qualified referees for all games and to keep them on time.
