



## SHOUT OUT TO PARENTS & SUPPORTERS

Aloha & Welcome to the 2026 AYSO Kirk Banks Tournament, which will be held at the Waipio Soccer Complex on March 20, 21, & 22, 2026. The Tournament committee would like to thank you in advance for your support of our youth and hope you enjoy the first of 3 AYSO Tournaments for 2026. In an effort to help you have an enjoyable experience, we'd like to provide you with the following information:

1. Parking is available throughout the park. Please park in marked stalls and be mindful of people (especially our keiki) walking through the parking areas. Parking restrictions will be enforced during tournament hours so please obey posted signs and drive carefully.
2. This is a City & County Park and the following apply:
  - a. Alcoholic beverages are prohibited inside the park
  - b. Use of tobacco products (including vaping) is not allowed inside the park.
  - c. Please do not bring pets to the park.
3. Skateboards, razors, wheeled wave boards, etc. are NOT allowed within the complex. E-bikes should only be used on roads and parking lots, and NOT on park sidewalks.
4. Game schedules and field maps will be posted at all referee tents, field monitor tents, and the main operations tent. Standings will be accessed by scanning the QR code at these tents.
5. Go to the main operations tent, located at the Stadium ticket booth, for tournament information, lost and found, or questions concerning the tournament.
6. Medical assistance is available if there is an emergency. Please flag down any roving golf cart or go to a tournament tent (referee or field monitor tent). All are equipped with two-way radios to contact medical personnel.
7. Off-duty police officers will be on hand for assistance and will be roving the park on golf carts. Go to any tournament tent to ask for help.
8. We welcome you to bring food & drink to the park (we love potlucks!) but please pick up your trash and clean up the area before you leave. Trash cans are located throughout the park.
9. Bathrooms are located in parking lots B, C, and the stadium ticket office.
10. The Stadium will not be used at this tournament.

We are all here to support our sons, daughters, grandchildren, nieces, nephews, cousins, and friends in the beautiful game of soccer. We all want them to do their best, but we want them to have fun too. Please remember that:

- a. THIS IS NOT THE WORLD CUP. (Those games start in June). This is AYSO soccer
- b. Cheer loudly for our keiki and be positive and encouraging.
- c. Remember that all of us who run the tournament are volunteers and we want to do our best for our kids. Please be tolerant when mistakes are made, and patient while we try to correct them if possible.
- d. A special reminder to those who think they know more than the referees on the field – yelling abusive comments does nothing for the game or the kids that are playing, so don't do it. Without exception, our referees try to do their best and need your support IF a mistake is made so let's be understanding. While we don't like to do it, the tournament will send police to the field if needed.
