## 2024 AYSO RAINBOW TOURNAMENT SAFETY PLAN

### **SAFETY DIRECTOR:**

Lei Leong is the RBT Safety Director. The safety director will complete all injury forms. SD has notified hospitals and fire stations within 10 minutes from the field regarding tournament dates and times.

### **COMMUNICATION:**

All tournament staff will be assigned two-way radios and will be asked to carry their cell phones while at the tournament. Cell phone numbers will be distributed to all staff members.

**SECURITY:** Mr. Terry Kong is the Tournament Security Director. He has contracted Three off duty police officers from the City & County of Honolulu to provide security at the tournament. A private security firm will be on site after hours until tournament staff relieves the guard in the morning. Police officers will have two-way radios to connect with tournament staff and cell phones for emergency calls.

### **FIELD MONITORS:**

Each Region will be assigned staff duties at the 3 field monitor tents strategically placed throughout the site. Each tent will have a binder with instructions and protocol for dealing injury or disturbances. Monitors will render assistance by contacting first aid for injuries or security for disturbances. Monitors will be briefed on Park evacuation procedures as outlined by Civil Authority.

### **FIRST AID:**

There will be a first aid tent staffed by trained AYSO volunteers. They will be stationed on site near tournament headquarters and equipped with two-way radios to communicate with field monitors and tournament staff. Two golf carts with flatbeds will be assigned to the first aid tent. AYSO Section 7 will provide all medical supplies. Ice and plastic bags will be replenished daily. Trained volunteers will provide first aid for minor injuries; will not dispense drugs; will assess major injuries and call 911.

### **TOURNAMENT SITE MAP:**

A map of the tournament fields and facilities including first aid and security stations will be posted on the site at the sandwich board and mailed out in pre-tournament coaches' packets.

### **DAILY TOURNAMENT SUMMARY MEETINGS:**

Mandatory daily tournament summary meetings for all staff will be held at the operations tent following the last game of each day. Safety needs and concerns will be addressed at meeting if not already dealt with.

**GOLF CARTS:** First Aid tent will have access to a cart at all times. Only tournament staff will be allowed to operate golf carts. Passengers must be seated in cart at all times.
