With the growth in teams we have had to cut back U10 divisions practice schedules to once a week. Not enough lit field space. We are actively looking for more lit fields for next season.

We just completed our fourth week of play. We have had to discipline a few coaches and parents about ref abuse on the sidelines. We have one BU10 coach which will miss one game this weekend due to his behavior last week.
