END-OF-MATCH REPORTING

SUBMIT

- 1) All teams, whether home or away, need to submit a Match Report.
- 2) Immediately after the game, make sure to take a photo of your own game card as well as the completed game card from the other team.
- Make sure all 3 referee names are listed.
- 4) For 16U-19U divisions teams, submit a photo of the substitution time sheet form for both teams.
- 5) Match reports need to be submitted within 48 hours otherwise points will be deducted from team standings after a certain amount of late/missing scores.
- 6) If the game is a forfeit, a match report still needs to be submitted. Upload ANY photo in place of the game card in order to submit the report.



Match Reporting

- It is the responsibility of **both coaches** to ensure the scores are reported within 48 hours of the match
 - Failure to do so will result in a caution for the head coach; multiple failures to timely and accurately report will lead to Standings Points deductions
- Accurate reporting is <u>required</u>
 - Home and Away scores
 - All Cautions and Send-offs (<u>for both teams</u>)
 - Pics of both sides of the game cards (<u>both game cards</u>)
 - Pics of substitution timesheet for <u>both teams</u> (16/19 only)
 - Note: Link to missing match reports on website



Area 1R Playoffs

- 14U Division
 - Each Region sends one team representative to Area R playoffs
 - Plus 1 Wildcard
 - Minimum 2 games
 - December 6-7
 - Location: Corona

- 16U / 19U Division
 - Top 4 teams in each division qualify for playoffs
 - Semi-Finals: played in top seeded regions
 - Finals: November 8
 - Location: TBA

Fall 2025 Guidelines

- Governing Rules of the Season
- **New Changes include:**
 - Certified referees required No "club linespersons"
 - Only one (1) captain from each team may approach the referee to discuss controversial or disputed calls. Other players must stay five (5) yards away.
 - Tougher Discipline: New USSF/AYSO Referee Abuse Prevention Program affects coaches, players, and spectators
 - And there's more....

Safe Sport

New in 2025- Federal Law

All players 18 years old or turning 18 in the season are required to take Safe Sport

Ten days before a Player's 18th Birthday, an email will be sent to the Player's registered parent(s). Both parents will only be notified if both are registered under the same family ID as the player. The player will only receive the invitation if the Player's email is on file.

Referee Abuse Prevention Program

- US Soccer and AYSO have rolled out new referee abuse prevention program
- AYSO National Policy (section 2.E.e)
- What is it?
 - The documentation, investigation, education, and sanctions for referee abuse that is "extreme and deliberate" and "causes significant harm" or "demonstrates a material lack of respect"
- How to document
 - Through match reports (coaches and players) or incident report (spectators)
- Area staff is working to streamline the process

Hitting, Punching, Elbowing, Kicking, Biting, Spiting, Choking, Tackling, Throwing or Use of Object or Any Part of Body (Forearm, Knee, Head) in a Striking Manner		12 Months - Lifetime

KEY PENALTY FACTORS

- Single offenses are at minimum the prescribed game penalty or time penalty for non red zone offenses
- Penalties can be both game and time depending on severity / circumstances
- Second time offenders receive double punishment
- Third time offenders receive a lifetime ban
- More than one offense at the same time is at least the punishment for the most serious offense
- Offenses against minors are automatically subject to a "minor multiplier" resulting in triple punishment
- One offense warning per league to be managed by states and leagues collaboratively
- Game consequences are inclusive of 1 game penalty for any red cards given
- Optionality for 50% penalty for first offense from a minor

Please follow your current reporting structure - updated reporting procedure will be a part of Phase 3.

(*) Disclaimer: These are only a few examples of abuse - other actions or statements may also fall into this category.

"Qualified Referee"

- 14U Matches: Intermediate Referee or higher 16U matches: Advanced Referee candidate or higher 19U matches: Advanced Referee or higher
- **CANNOT** be head coach, assistant coach, or relative of player
- Report all send-offs (or spectator ejections) on Area website
- Completed all required courses

 O Referee Course, Safe Haven, CDC Concussion, Live Scan, Sudden Cardiac Arrest, SafeSport (current), and AYSO sterling background check (current)
- Standards for "Qualified Assistant Referees" are different

Check In By Referees

- Required at the start of the game
 - If not done, please add to match report
- Coaches must provide printed Team Picture Roster.
 There's no requirement to laminate the roster; print multiple copies!
- If a team doesn't have a Team Picture Roster, the game will be a **forfeit** but the teams can play a scrimmage
- If a player is not listed on the Team's Roster, then the player cannot play in the game
- The referees do not have the discretion to waive these consequences



Sideline Etiquette and Behavior

- Sidelines will sit on the side opposite of the AR
- Any abuse of the referee will be reason for removal of the spectator and/or coach
- We are especially protective of our youth referees
- NO PETS AT ANY FIELD





Standings

Win: 3 points
Tie: 1 point
Loss/Forfeit: 0 points


 Minus 1 point for each send-off of a player, coach, or spectator (up to 3 per game)

- Minus 1 point as the team reaches its 3rd,
 5th, 7th, etc. late, inaccurate, or incomplete reporting of the game results
- Will use CGI Sports Standings for Fall
