2026 SPRING SELECT PROGRAM

AYSO Spring Select is a competitive season for teams that play in matches and tournaments all across Southern California. It is a great way for the players to improve their skills as soccer players in a fun and competitive environment. The purpose of this team is to allow those players who have demonstrated soccer ability and who have displayed an attitude for fair play, enthusiasm and cooperative team spirit to participate on a team of players who have similar qualifications.

Participation on this team requires an increased commitment from both parents and players, including attendance at all practices and matches as well as a sense of responsibility toward coaches and other team members. This team will compete in tournament play; these tournaments include travel and both Saturday and Sunday matches. The team is financially self-supporting, so fund-raising will be required for each player and parents are expected to participate.

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Match Reporting

- It's the responsibility of both coaches to ensure the scores are reported **within 48 hours of the match**
 - *Multiple failures to completely, timely, and accurately report will lead to Standings Points deductions*
- **Accurate reporting is Required**
 - Home and Away scores
 - All Cautions and Send-offs (for both teams)
 - Pictures of both sides of the game cards (both game cards)
 - Pictures of substitution timesheet for both teams (16U/19U only)

- **Minus 1 point** as the team reaches its 3rd, 5th, 7th, etc. late, inaccurate, or incomplete reporting of the game results
- Will use CGI Sports Standings for Spring

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Safe Sport

New in 2025- Federal Law

**All players 18 years old or turning 18 in the season are
required to take Safe Sport**

Ten days before a Player's 18th Birthday, an email will be sent to the Player's registered parent(s). Both parents will only be notified if both are registered under the same family ID as the player.

The player will only receive the invitation if the Player's email is on file.



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Spring 2026 Guidelines

- Governing Rules of the Season for Spring Select & Area Interleague
- If it is not specified within the guidelines, revert to your own region's guidelines.
Do not impose your region rules on a visiting team.
 - *ie. Playtime, Goalkeeper playtime rules, Slide Tackling*
- **Significant changes from last year include:**
 - **Spring Select:**
 - No club linespersons (except in an emergency)
 - **Area Interleague:**
 - Coach certifications - Intermediate Coach is fine for all divisions
 - Who is a "Qualified Referee" for an Area Interleague match?
 - No club linespersons (except in an emergency)

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Referee Abuse Prevention Program

- US Soccer and AYSO have rolled out new **referee abuse prevention** program
- [AYSO National Policy](#) (section 2.E.e)
- What is it?
 - The documentation, investigation, education, and sanctions for referee abuse that is *“extreme and deliberate”* and *“causes significant harm”* or *“demonstrates a material lack of respect”*
- How to document
 - *Through match reports (coaches and players) or incident report (spectators)*
- Area staff is working to streamline the process

(*) **Disclaimer:** These are only a few examples of abuse – other actions or statements may also fall into this category.

KEY PENALTY FACTORS

- Single offenses are at **minimum the prescribed game penalty or time penalty** for non red zone offenses
- Penalties can be **both game and time depending on severity** / circumstances
- Second time offenders receive **double punishment**
- Third time offenders receive a **lifetime ban**
- More than one offense at the same time is **at least the punishment for the most serious offense**
- Offenses against minors are automatically subject to a **“minor multiplier” resulting in triple punishment**
- **One offense warning per league** to be managed by states and leagues collaboratively
- Game consequences are **inclusive of 1 game penalty for any red cards given**
- Optionality for **50% penalty for first offense from a minor**

Please follow your current reporting structure – updated reporting procedure will be a part of Phase 3.



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Check-in by Referees

- Required at the start of the game
 - *If not done, please add to match report*
- Coaches provide the Team Picture Roster.
 - *There's no requirement to laminate the roster; print multiple copies!*
- If a team doesn't have a Team Picture Roster, the game will be a **forfeit** and the teams can play a scrimmage
- If a player is not listed on the Team's Roster, then the player **cannot play in the game**
- **The referees do not have the discretion to waive these consequences**



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Spring Select “Qualified Referee”

- 10U and 12U Matches: *Regional Referee or higher*
- 14U Matches: *Intermediate Referee or higher*
- The team’s coach or assistant coach cannot be a referee or AR
- A parent or relative of a player cannot be the referee (but can be an AR)
- **Report all send-offs (or spectator ejections) on Spring Select website**
- Completed all required courses
 - *Referee Course, Safe Haven, CDC Concussion, Live Scan, Sudden Cardiac Arrest, SafeSport (current), and AYSO Sterling Background Check (current)*

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Area 1R Interleague “Qualified Referee”

- **14U Matches:** *Intermediate Referee or higher*
- **16U - 19U Matches:**
 - *16U matches - Advanced Referee candidate or higher*
 - *19U matches - Advanced Referee or higher*
Intermediate Referee or higher (if an Advanced Referee is not available)
 - **All Interleague Matches:**
 - *Assistant coach, parent, or relative may NOT be the referee*
 - *Assistant coach, parent, or relative may be an assistant referee (If in uniform)*
- **Report all send-offs (or spectator ejections) on Area 1R Interleague website**
- Completed all required courses
 - *Referee Course, Safe Haven, CDC Concussion, Live Scan, Sudden Cardiac Arrest, SafeSport (current), and AYSO Sterling Background Check (current)*



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Sideline Etiquette and Behavior

- Sidelines will sit on the side opposite of the AR
- Any abuse of the referee will be reason for removal of the spectator and/or coach
- We are especially protective of our youth referees
- **No pets at any park**
